The City of Stanwood contracts its police services through the Snohomish County Sheriff’s Office. The population for Stanwood is currently 6,220, however due to the makeup of the community the service population is 40,000. Stanwood’s city limit encompasses 3.78 square miles. City density per square mile is 1,967 with 1,050 persons living in the designated flood plain area.

Detective Report – July 2013

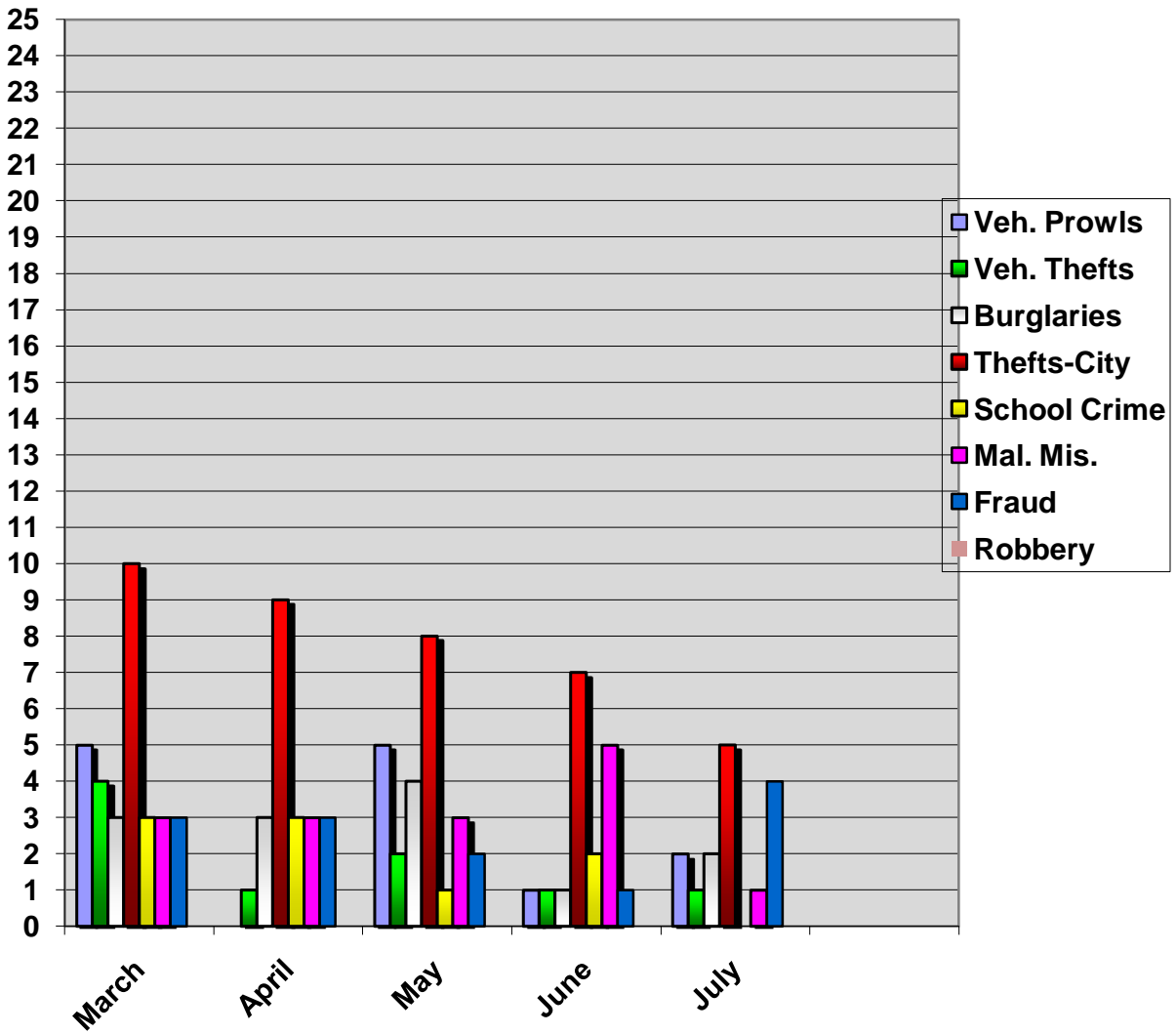
The case involving the theft of several hundred dollars of paint ball gear has been solved to an extent. Much of the stolen gear has been recovered and returned to its owner. It turns out the suspect who was mentioned in the initial report can be tied to the sale of these items via his phone number. Apparently what he does is use Craigslist's "WTB" (Want to Buy) feature. This is a basic on line published shopping list with awaiting and eager customers to hand pick from. The criminal or suspect/s in this case use this Craigslist feature to locate items they need to steal or already know the whereabouts of; or start a search of people looking for specific items the criminal is already in possession of. He then contacts them by via phone, in this case using his cell phone. What this does is eliminates most of the electronic trail, IE the suspect is no longer posting the items he has for sale, thus creating an add which would tie him to an e mail address or posting ID number, which can be traced to a specific computer, all of which can be served via a warrant. In this case instead of using a drop phone to conceal the trail even further this suspect actually used his own phone.

Both of the victims in this case were able to describe the suspect and vehicle used, however one was not able to pick him out in a line up. Both victims however were able to provide the phone number used in the transaction. Both were contacted by the suspect and met with him on the same day in the same parking lot. This transaction took place only hours after the theft. The meeting place for the sale of the stolen property was two counties away in the Tacoma area.

I was able to assist the suspect in being arrested on a warrant by a Bail Bonds and taken to Island County Jail. I drove to the Jail to meet with him but he refused to speak with me. The suspect has a long history on theft and trafficking in stolen property and is currently facing several years in prison on pending charges out of Island County.

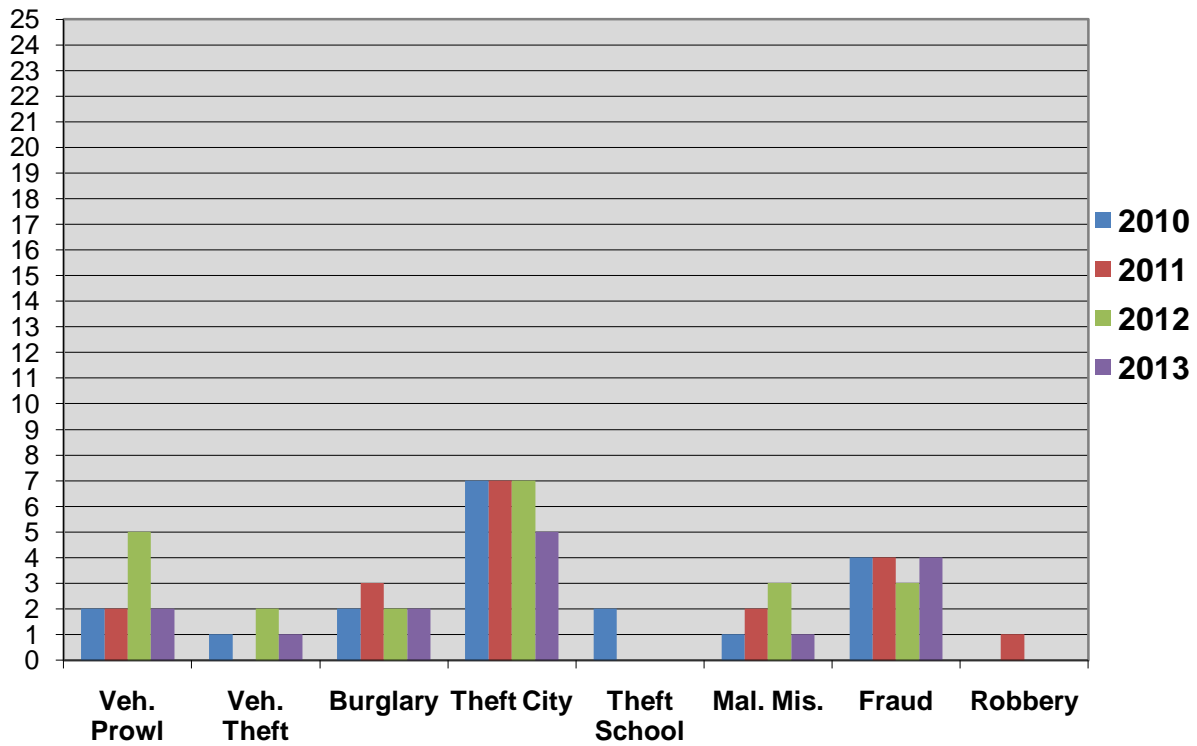
I will be referring additional charges on the suspect after I tie up a few additional loose ends in this case.
