The population for Stanwood is currently 6,220, however due to the makeup of the community the service population is 40,000. Stanwood's city limit encompasses 3.78 square miles. City density per square mile is 1,967 with 1,050 persons living in the designated flood plain area.

Trends:

During the month of November we had a significant increase in the theft of motor vehicles. Several of the thefts targeted specific vehicles such as Subaru's. During this same time two Snohomish County Sheriff's Office Deputies located two of our stolen vehicles while checking a suspicious residence off the Stanwood Bryant road. The vehicles were recovered in addition to property stolen from various vehicle prowls throughout the region including Skagit County. A suspect in the case was identified and arrested on unrelated warrants. The case is still under investigation. We have not received any vehicle theft complaints in the City of Stanwood since the arrest.

Fingerprinting Services:(New listing for 2013). The Stanwood Police Department provides fingerprint services to the public for Concealed Pistol Licenses and job applications to name just a few. We are now including this information into the monthly report.

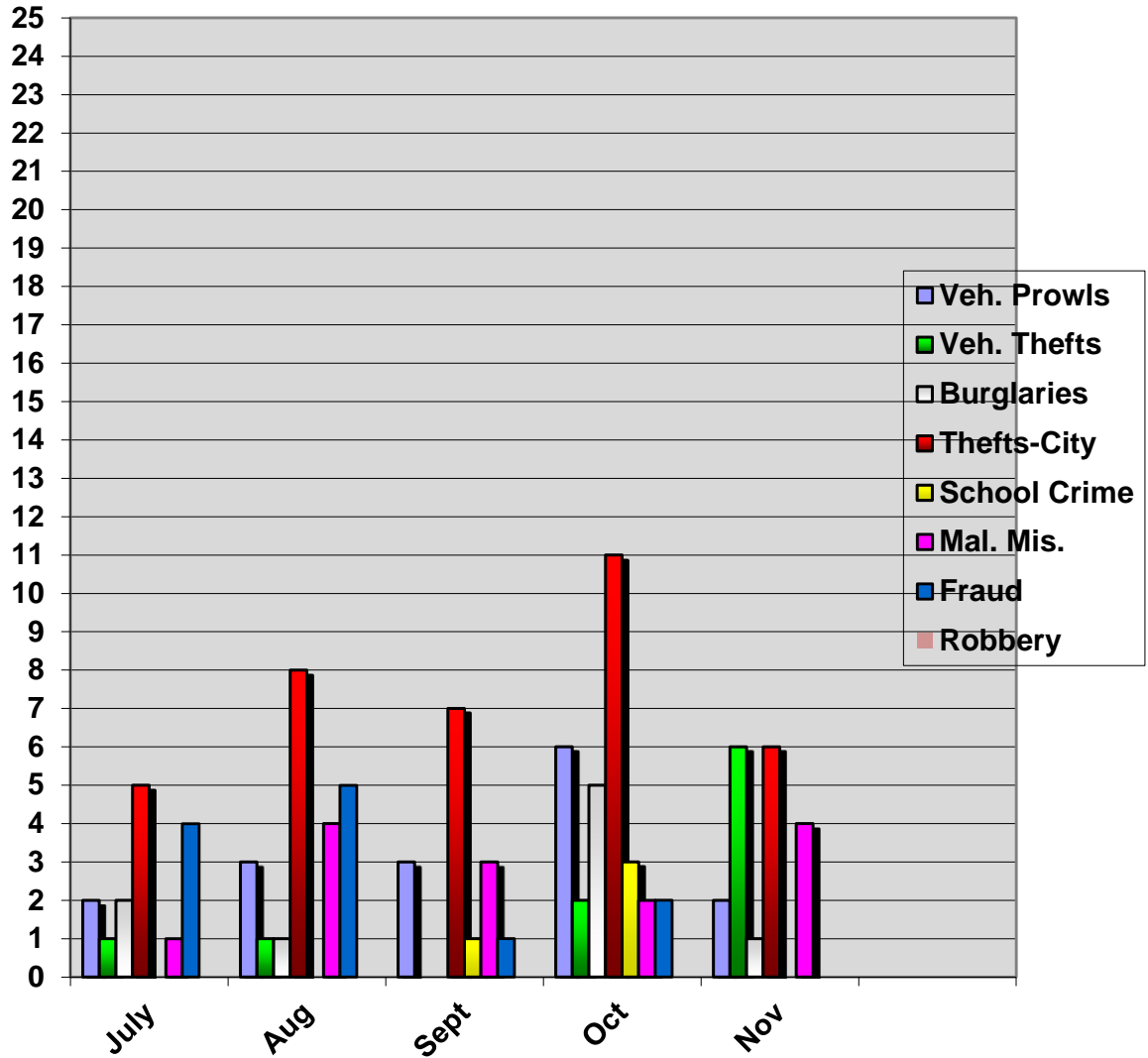
Detective Report – November 2013

The month of November and back into part of the month of October showed a noticeable increase in vehicle thefts within the City of Stanwood. A suspect was identified while Deputies were investigating an unrelated matter off the Stanwood Bryant road. During that investigation two of Stanwood's stolen vehicles were recovered. A suspect was identified, arrested and booked into the Snohomish County jail on unrelated warrants, bringing the theft of Subaru's in the City of Stanwood to a stop.

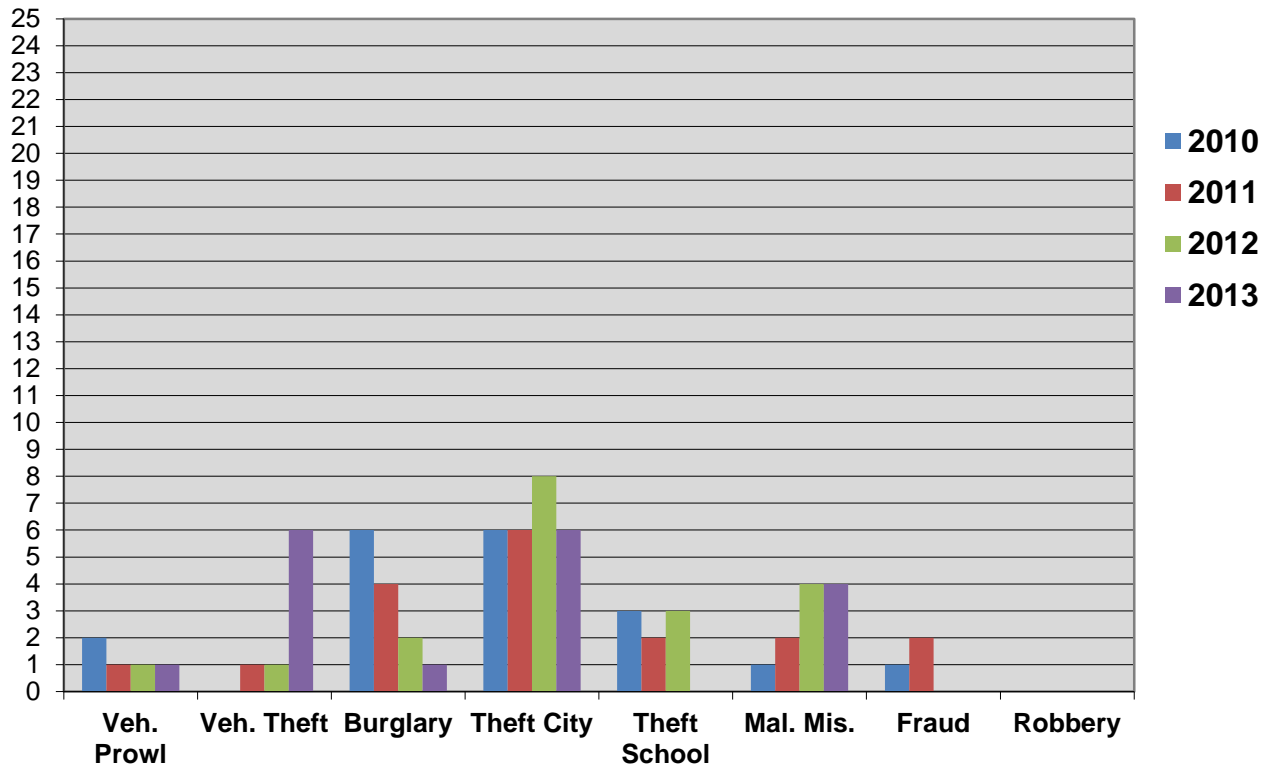
I began work on the Theft case involving the SCLL. The allegation suggested the Treasurer of this Non Profit had been taking monies over the past two years. After an audit had been completed by the current Treasurer; an estimation of funds taken over the tenure of the previous Treasurer reached several thousand dollars. All the information in this case was compiled and the suspect in this case was contacted and questioned. Charges in this case are being referred to the Prosecutors Office.

I am still working on the burglary case involving the stolen Corvette. This case just keeps getting bigger and involving more people. I am hoping to have it charged by the middle of this month, potentially charging five persons with numerous felonies.
