The population for Stanwood is currently 6,220, however due to the makeup of the community the service population is 40,000. Stanwood's city limit encompasses 3.78 square miles. City density per square mile is 1,967 with 1,050 persons living in the designated flood plain area.

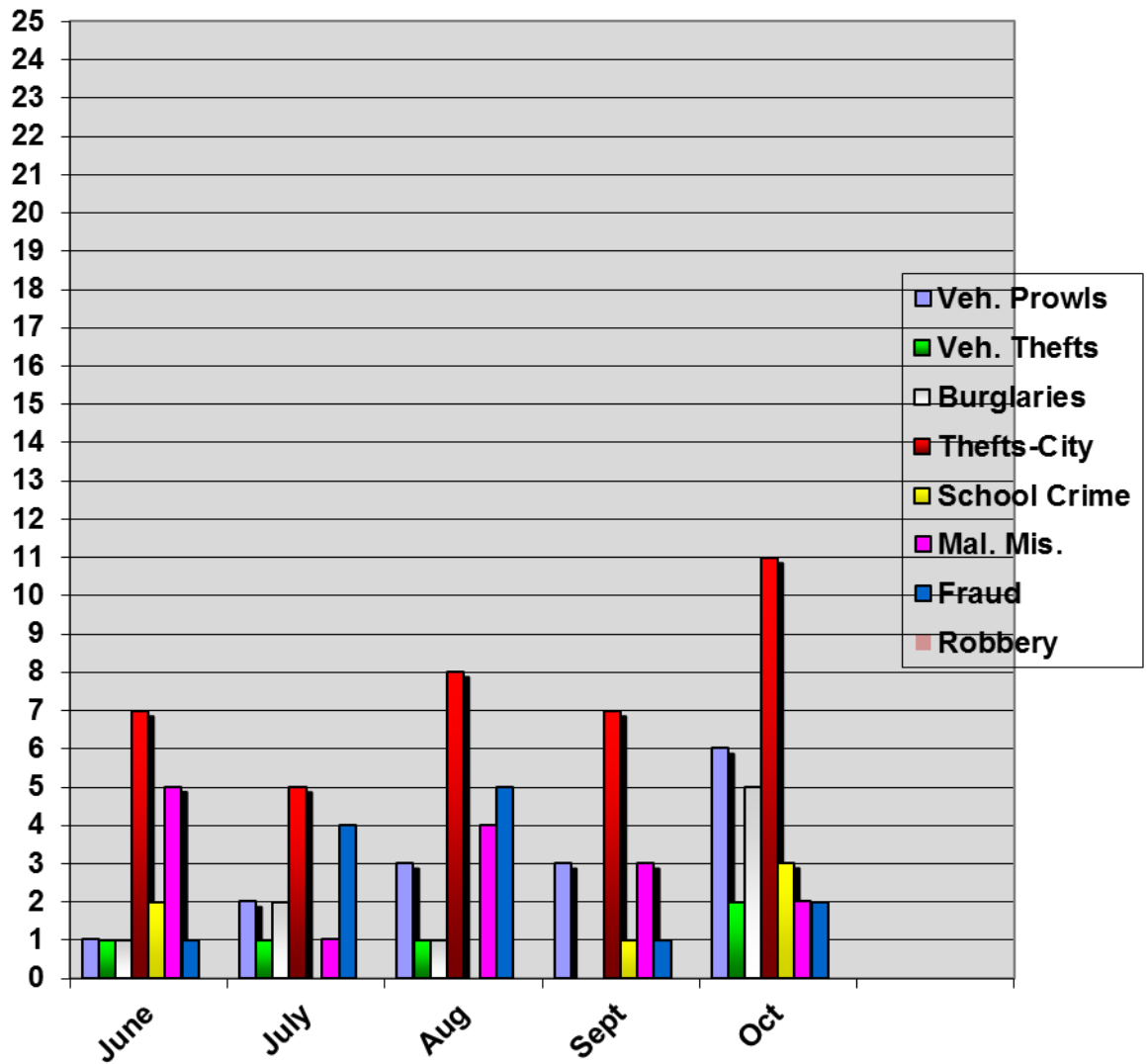
Detective Report – October 2013

The month of October showed some spikes in crime as you can see.

I have been working on the Burger King Burglary and have identified a suspect in the case. It appears this person is the same person who hit the Hair Masters a few months ago. He is responsible for about 39 commercial burglaries in King County and can be tied to several in Snohomish County. He was arrested by Directed Patrol and booked into the Snohomish County Jail. There are approximately 50 to 60 commercial burglary cases pending on this person.

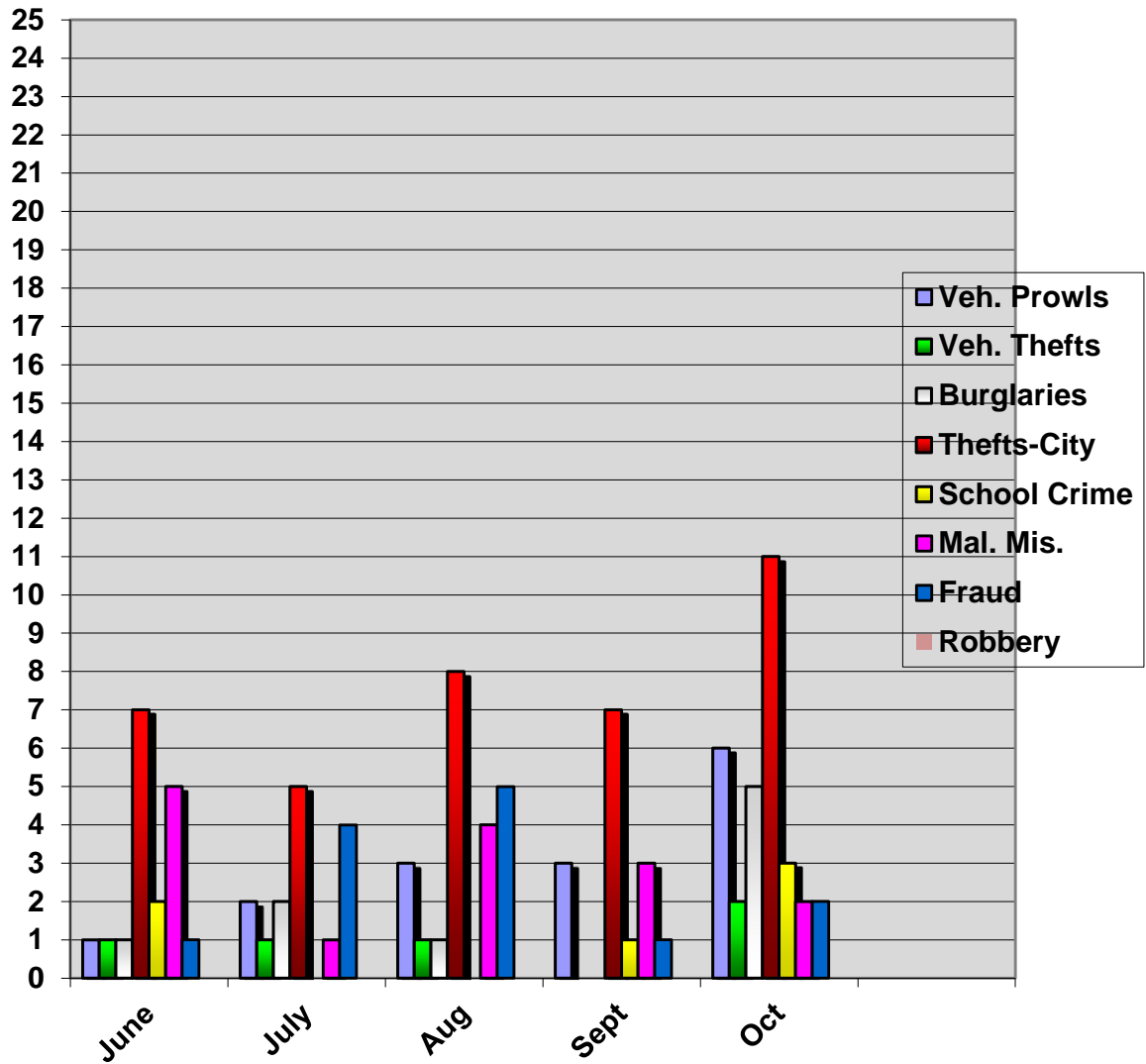
I received information that a well-known car thief is driving around in a red Corvette. As it turns out the victim who has a Stanwood address was in jail when his house was burglarized and his vehicle stolen. Through a long series of phone calls and tracking previous owners; I was able to determine the car thief had fraudulently transferred the title to the Corvette into his name using a stolen Notary Stamp and forged signatures. I was then able to recover the vehicle along with some of the victim's property stolen from his residence. It turns out this crew of thief's consisting of four people, two of which are career criminals are operating in this area. The individual was arrested on a DOC warrant and is an 11 time convicted felon with approx. 68 total convictions he is 45 years old. I am still working on this case as several more arrests are pending.
