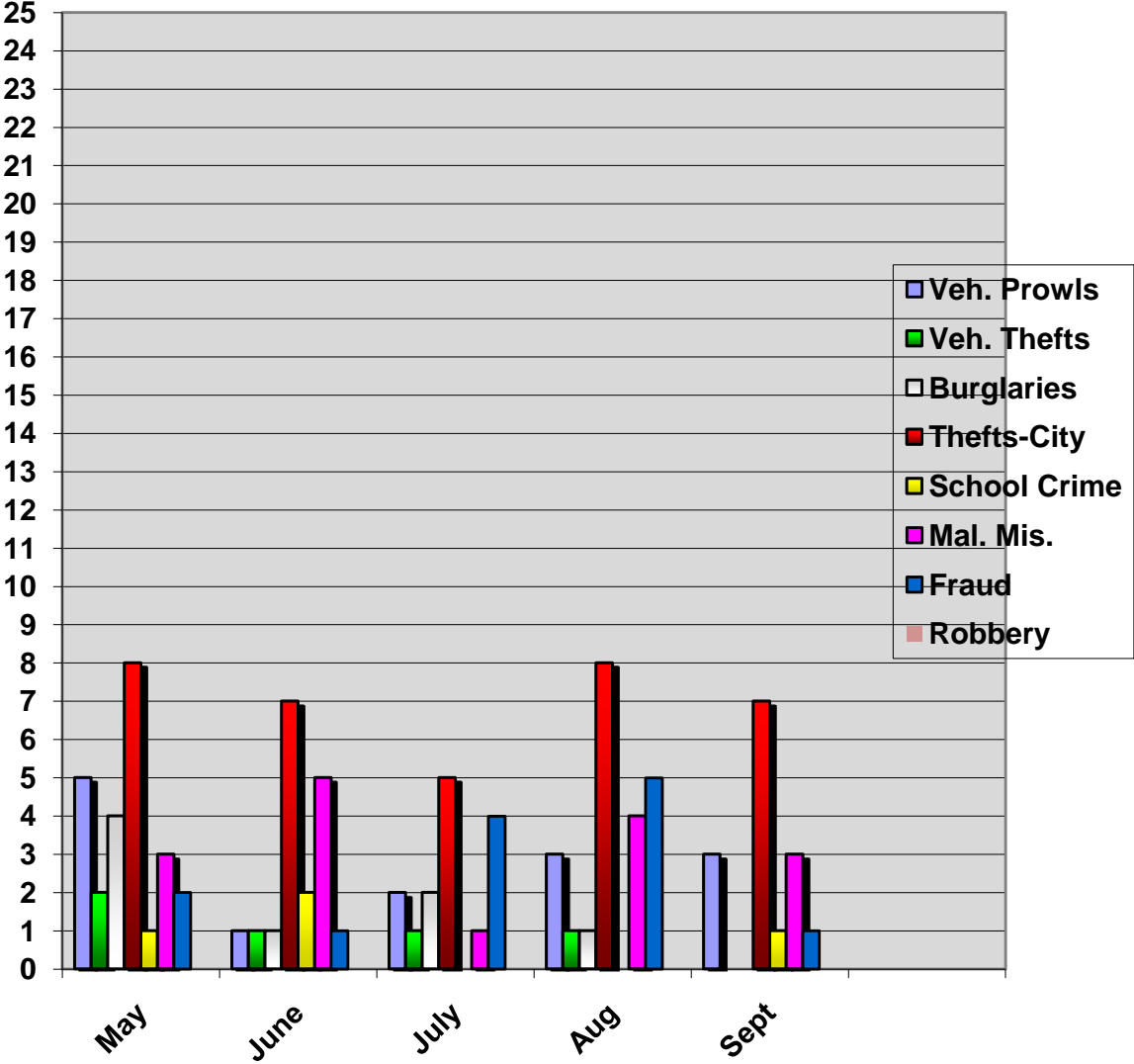

## **Detective Report – September 2013**

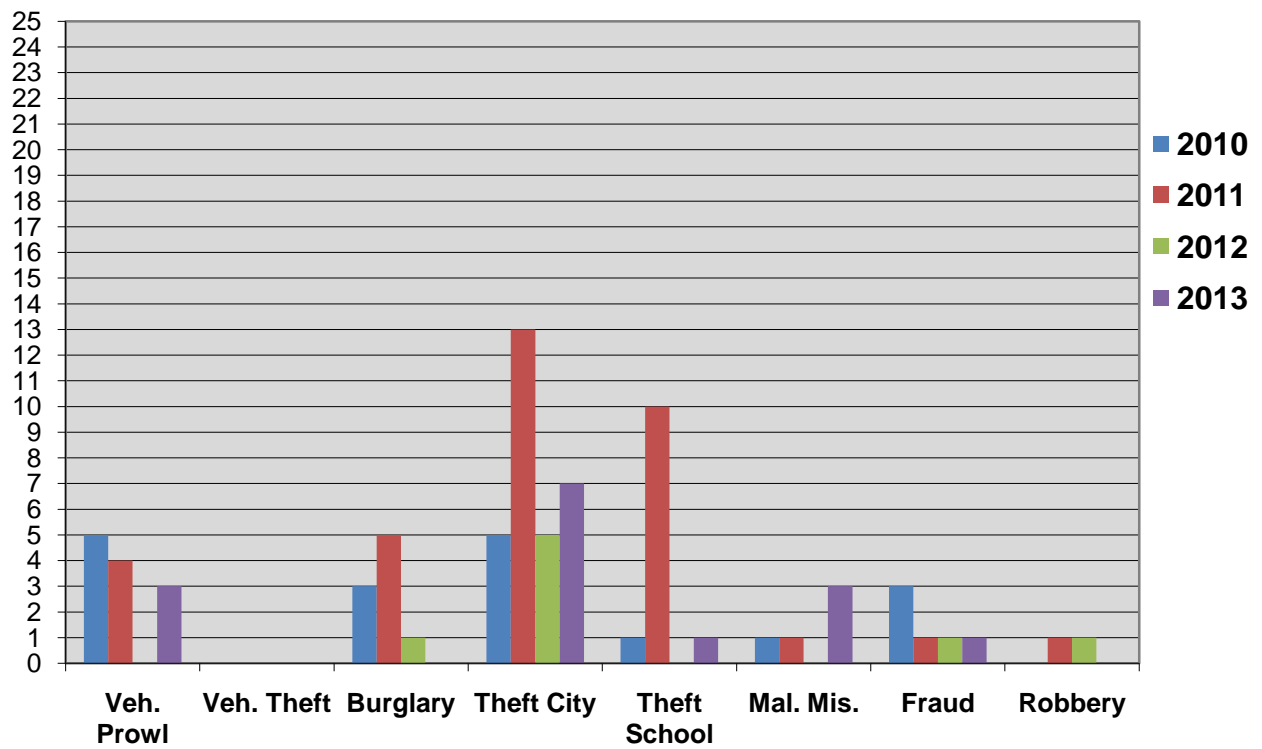
I had an opportunity to interview the suspect involved in the theft of the toilet valves. I met with him in Maryville at the DOC Office with his Probation Officer. He was not aware I was there to talk with him so I had an opportunity to sit in on his Probation meeting. Needless to say after his Probation Officer was finished with him and I introduced myself and we began talking he ended up confessing to the theft of the toilet valves in the city of Stanwood and one other incident in the city of Marysville. His took the valves to sell them for scrap telling me they are made of brass and weigh about seven to ten pounds each. He scraped them at the Marysville recycler just north of the Fred Meyer on State St. which included the potential charge of trafficking stolen property in addition to several theft charges.

The Ace Hardware's theft involving a well known female who steals and then returns items for cash was assigned to me for review. After reviewing video with store employees and double checking store inventories and cash sales I was able to establish probable cause to arrest the female for theft and trafficking in stolen property. As soon as the owner of Ace Hardware provides me with the necessary documentation I will forward charges to the prosecutors.
