City density per square mile is 1,967 with 1,050 persons living in the designated flood plain area.

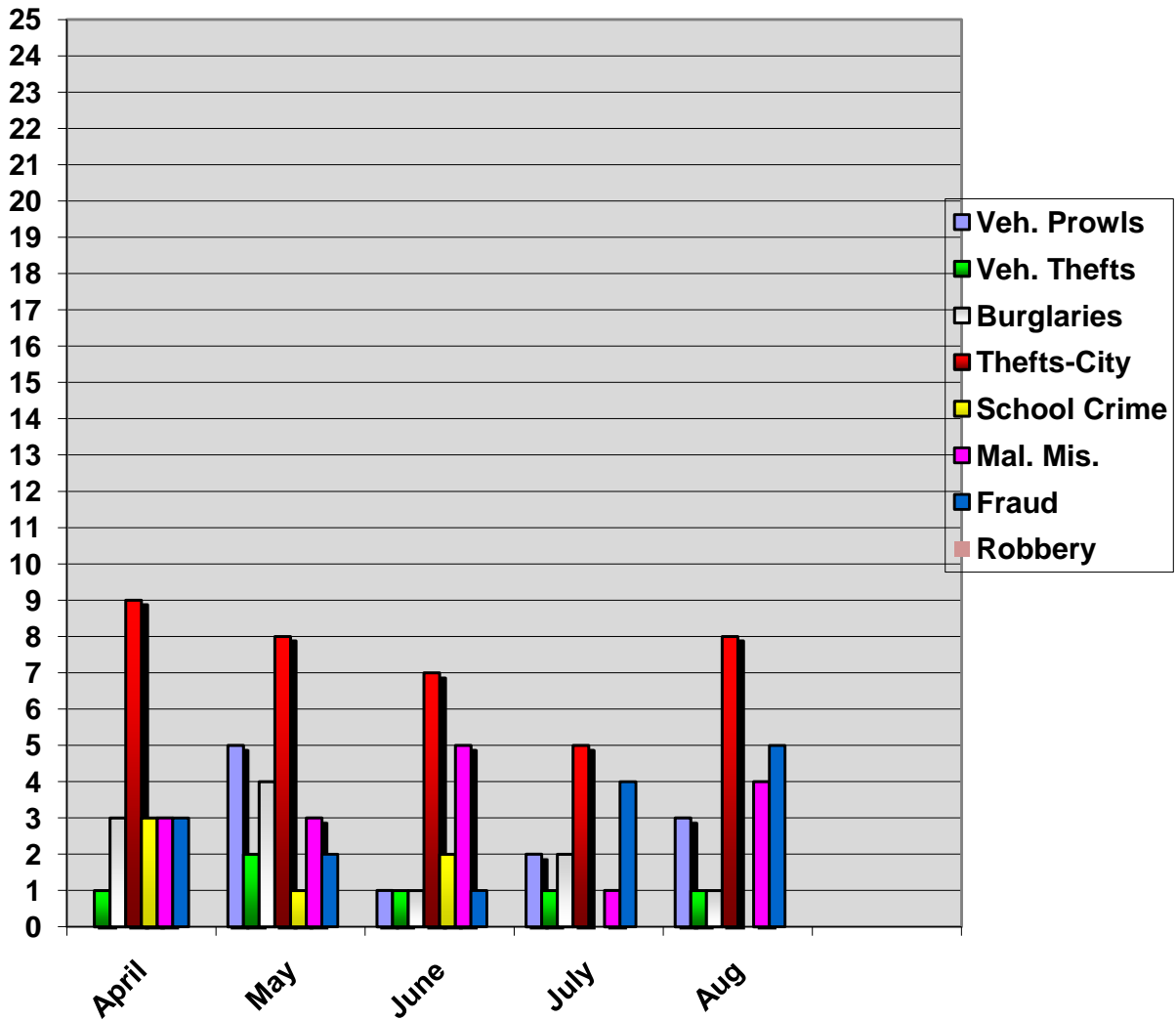
Stanwood Camano School District Report **School Out for the Summer**

Detective Report – August 2013

This month I finished up on the Josephine Sunset check fraud incident. This took place a couple of months ago. At some point one of Josephine's pay roll checks was forged and an attempt was made to cash the forged check. The person who cashed the check made no attempt to conceal his identity, using his real name on the check and presenting his driver's license at the time he tried to cash the check. A simple check with DOL confirmed this; using a known signature from DOL and matching it to the endorsed signature on the back of the forged check then comparing the bank video to the DOL picture confirmed the suspect's identity. The case had some twists due to the fact a former employee had been terminated at about the same time. This third party a juvenile used the same account number from his final pay roll check to open a Pay Pal account in the same time frame. His intent was to purchase a computer for himself, (After he was located and questioned) although he never made the purchase once the Pay Pal account was opened using Josephine's checking account number. Pay Pal conducted three test charges to verify the account was active. These charges normally are reversed once the account is confirmed, which did occur a few days later. It was determined the Juvenile played no part in the check fraud portion of the case. The two incidents were determined to be unrelated. The appropriate charges were referred to the Prosecutors Office.

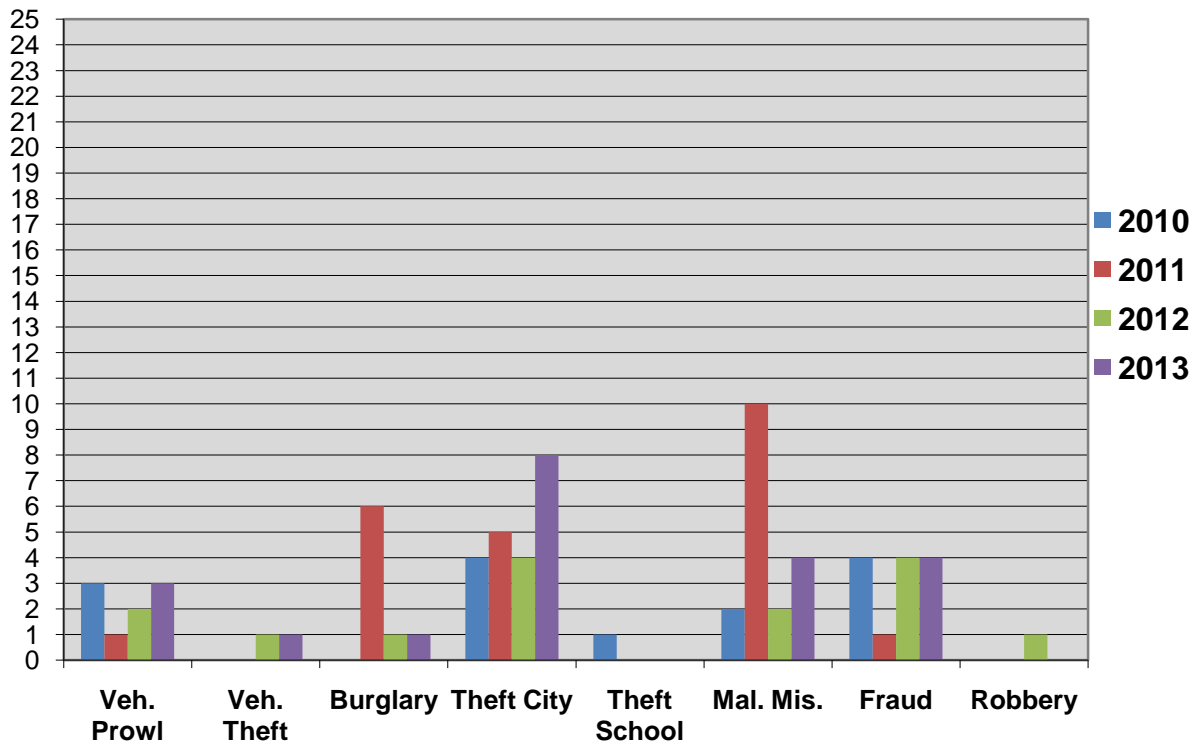
Another case was also resolved involving the theft of toilet valves from three separate business bathrooms in the Stanwood area. It turns out a male was identified on video entering the male bathroom with a tool bag. He spent several minutes in the bathroom then exited. When an employee entered the bathroom to check on its cleanliness they discovered the toilet valve in the stall had been removed / stolen. In a combined effort with Island County with individual efforts from Sgt Barry Ruchty and Island County Deputy Joe Urich the male was successfully identified. It turns out he is on DOC supervision and living on Camano Island. I will be hopefully speaking with him today along with his DOC Probation Officer to see what motivated him to steal these toilet valves. I will let you know how that goes..... Stay Safe.....
