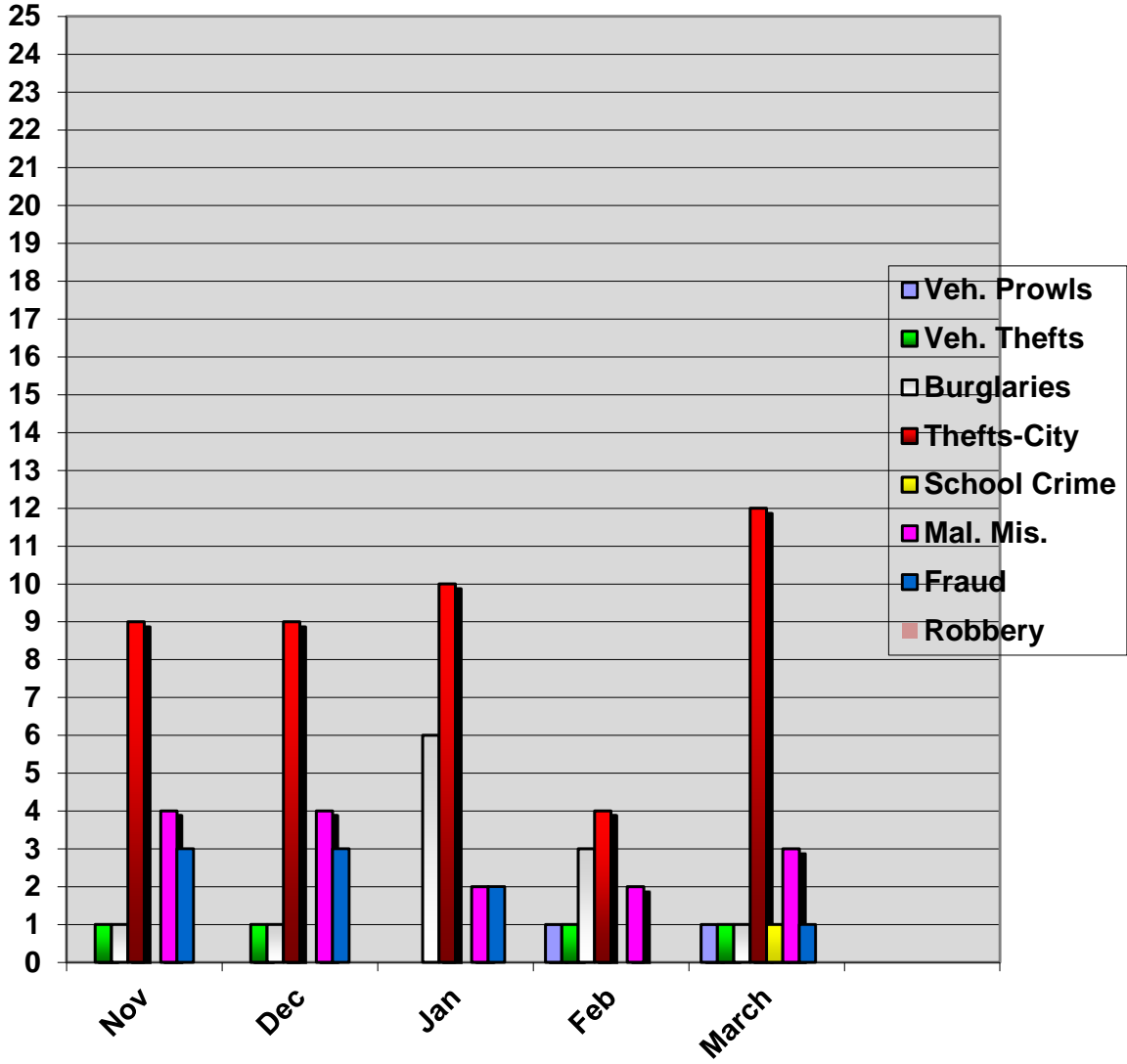

## **Detective Report – March 2015**

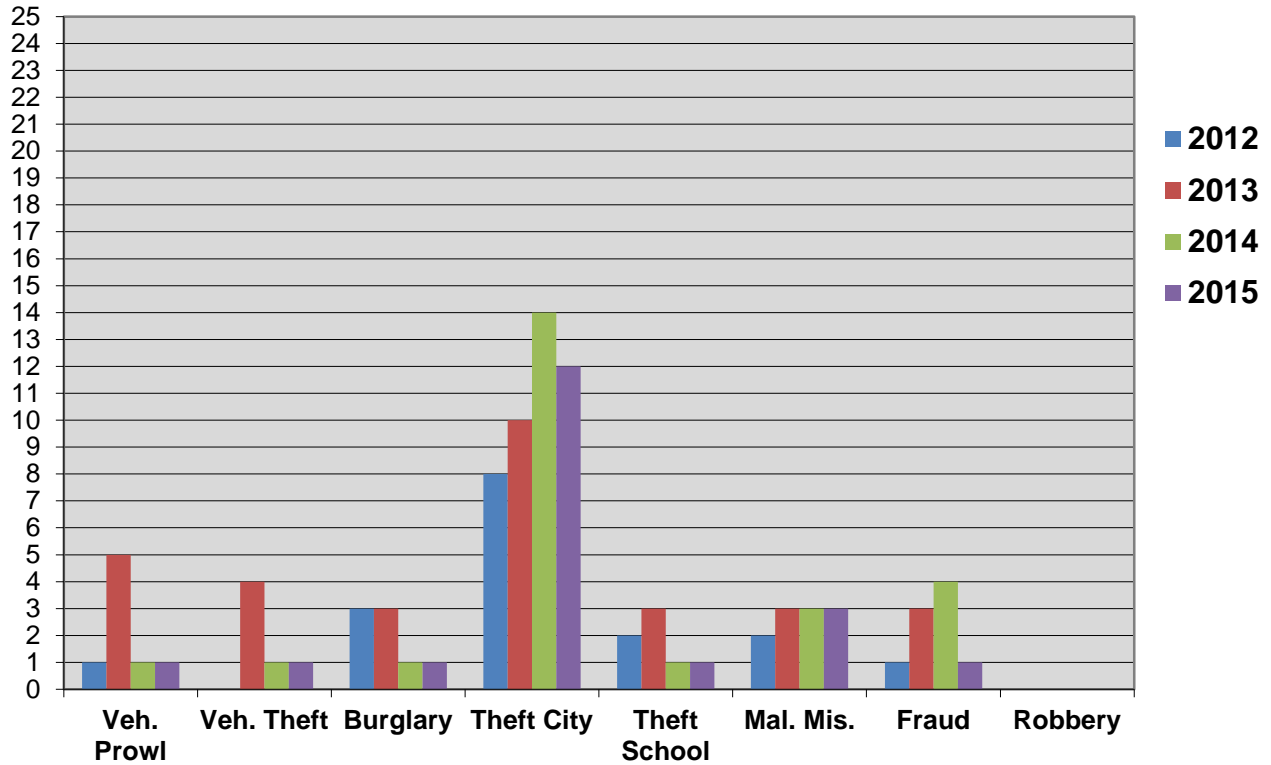
The suspect in the Costal Vie Espresso Robbery did not appear for court. A warrant was subsequently issued for his arrest. Information was developed through Washington's most wanted as to where he was hiding out. After several texts back and forth with David Rose of Washington's Most Wanted and then with the Island County Sheriff's Office a location for the suspect was identified. The suspect was located and arrested without incident and booked into the Snohomish County Jail.

I am currently working with the Drug Task Force on several active investigations. I am hoping they will have a positive local impact in the city of Stanwood. We have already made two arrests related to drug trafficking in addition to several warrant arrests. I will provide additional information next month.
