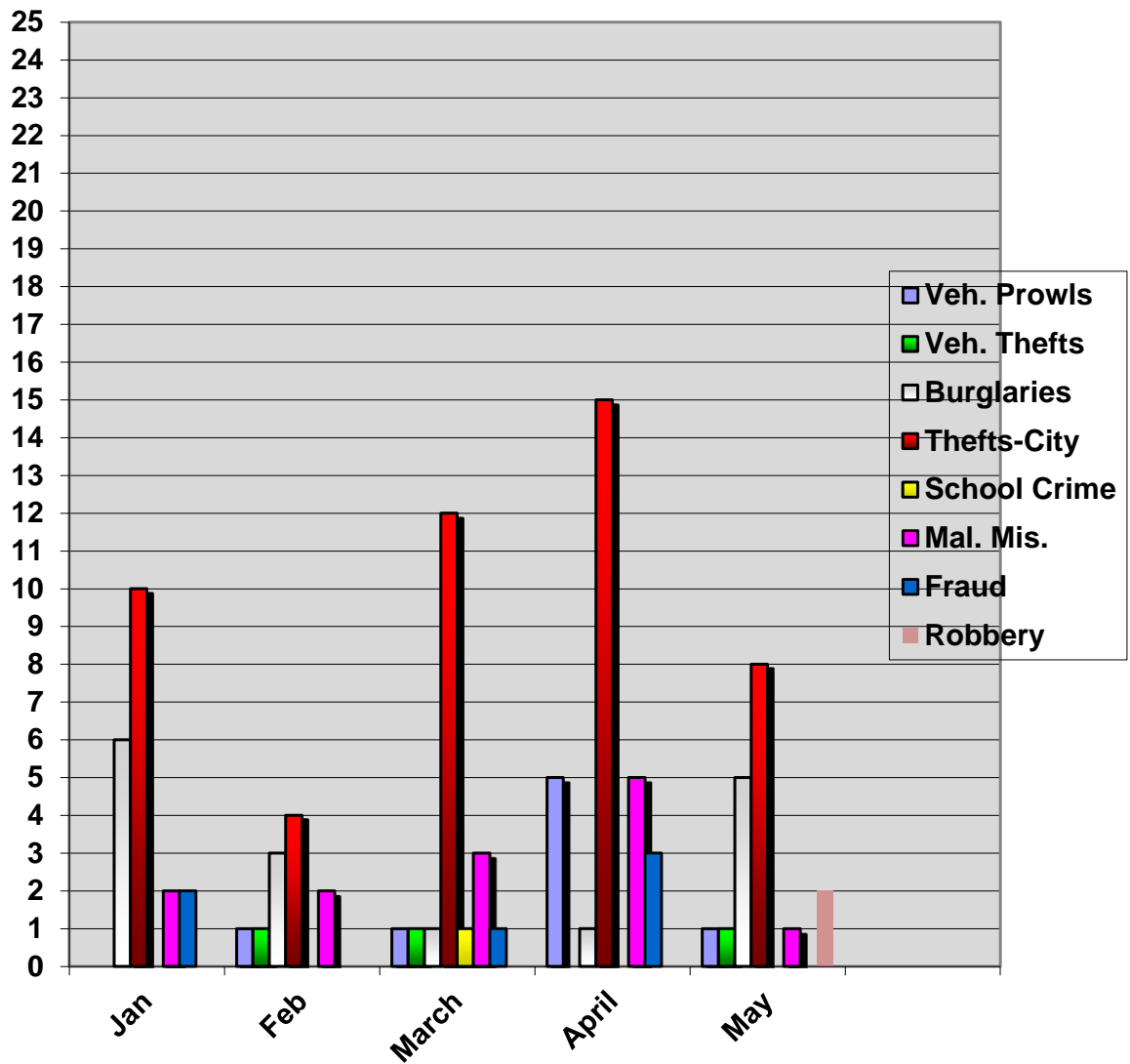

## Detective Report – May 2015

The month of May was pretty eventful. It began with the theft of a school bus; which ended up being recovered in the city of Blaine WA. The person who stole the bus struck a Blaine Police vehicle in an apparent attempt to escape. The suspect then drove the bus over several logs near the entrance to a park which disabled the bus. The suspect which was an adult female fled on foot and jumped into the bay. She was then rescued from the water and booked into the Whatcom County Jail. She is facing several felony level charges both in Whatcom County and Stanwood.

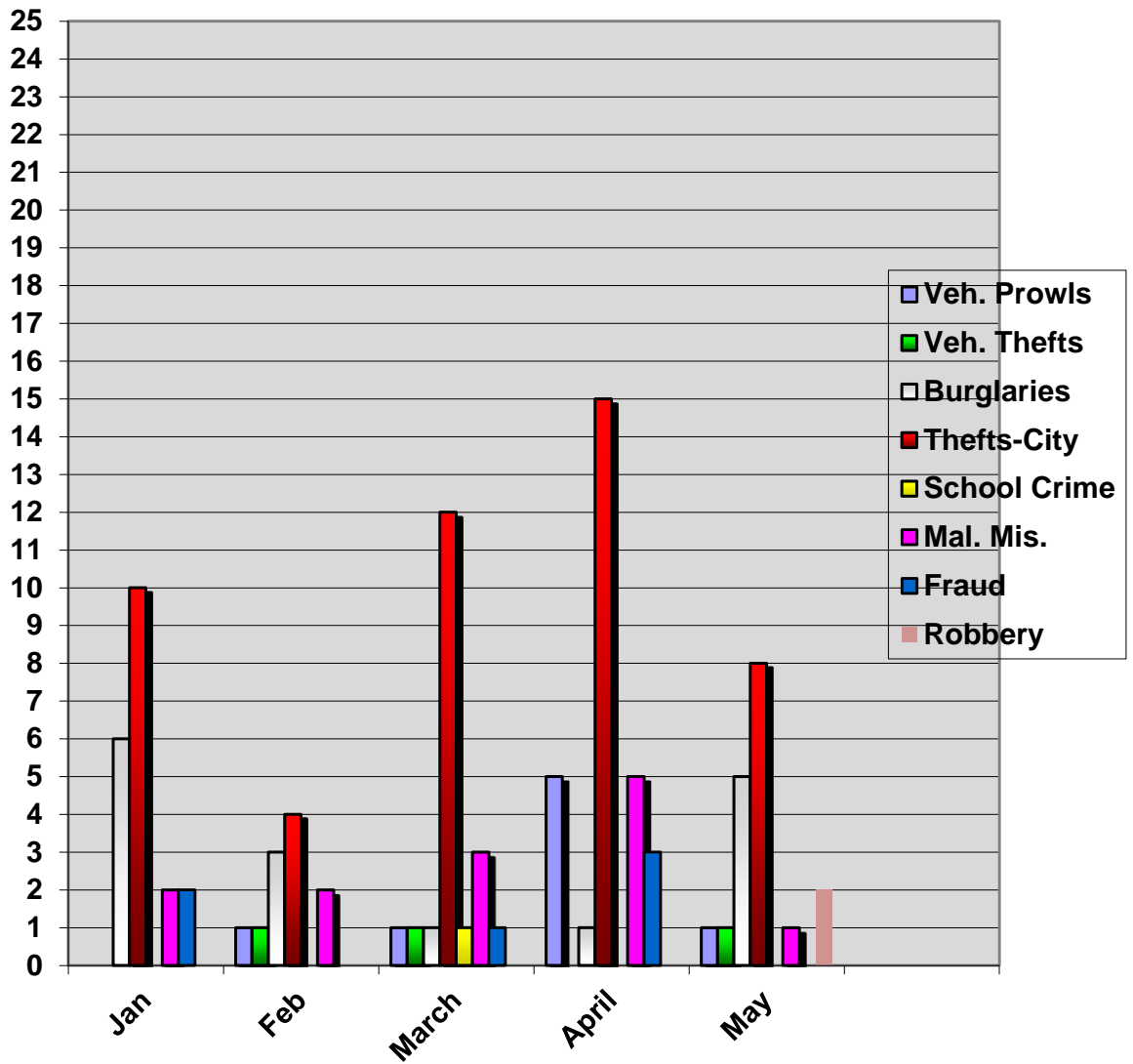
On 5-14-2015 around 10:50pm Stanwood Patrol were dispatched to an assault that occurred in the QFC parking lot. When Deputies arrived they learned that two adult males in their early twenties had chased the victim (17 year old male) from Haggens' parking lot to QFC after a few words were exchanged. One of the adult males hit the victim in the face knocking him down. While the victim was down on the ground the suspect took his hat and drove away. The suspects were located and arrested for Robbery 2nd and DUI. The suspect's vehicle was seized and a search warrant was granted to search the vehicle. The stolen hat was recovered along with other evidence.
