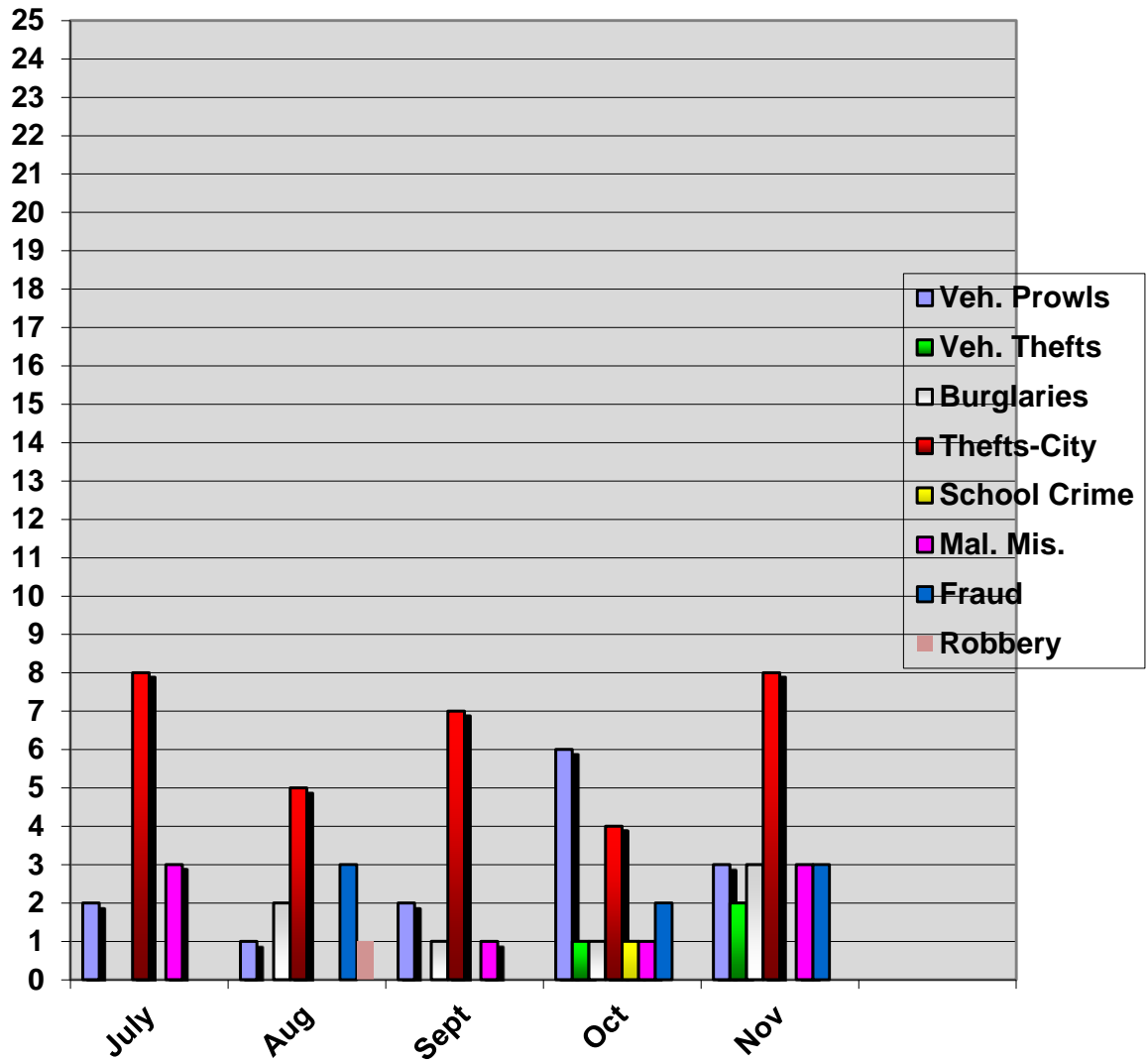
Detective Report – November 2015

Port Susan Middle School assault investigation has been completed and referred to the prosecutor for charging.

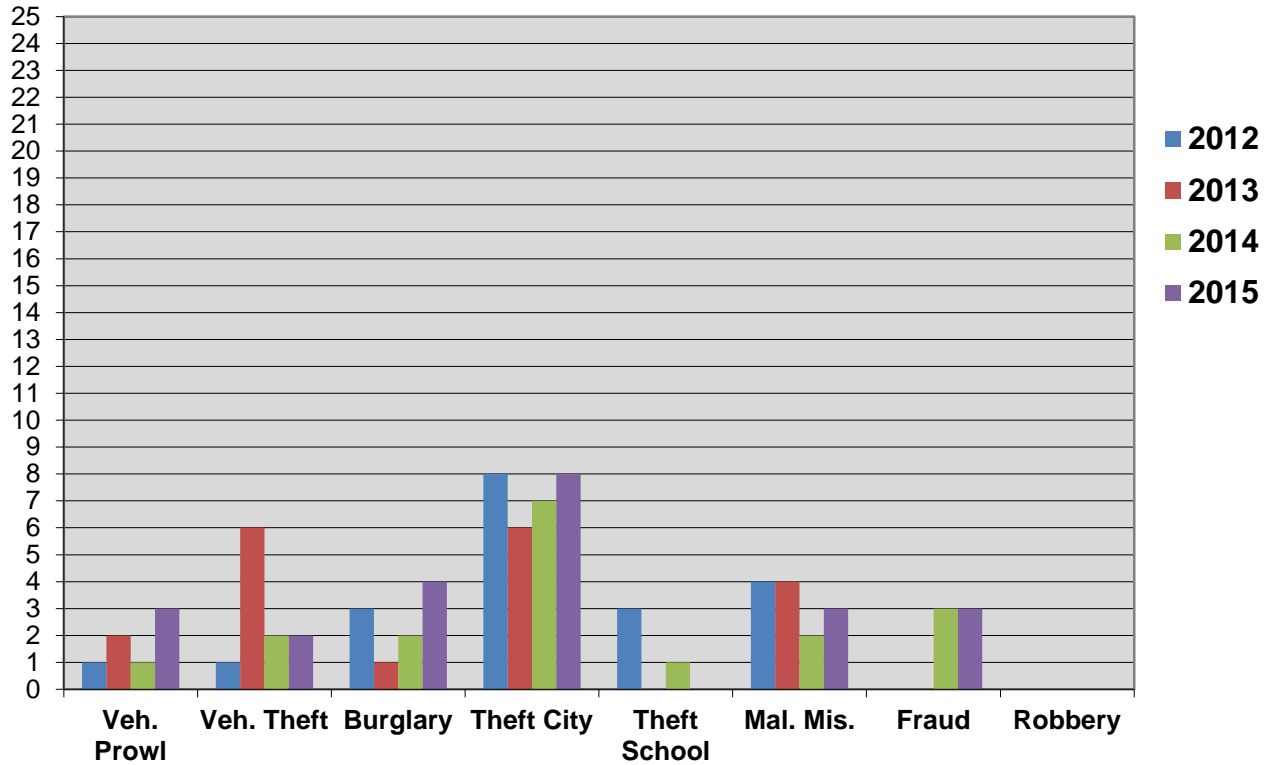
Check Fraud case # 543 involving the theft of checks and then altering the checks through a process referred to as washing has been solved. After altering the checks the suspect deposited them in a separate account. The fraud resulted in approximately \$720.00 being stolen from the victims account. The suspect was identified with the use of bank video. The suspect has since left the state so charges were referred.

I have also been assigned two other fraud cases, 15413 and 15415. Two separate incidents involving the same victim or house hold. This case involved a care giver taking the credit card and debit cards from their patient and his family. After recovering video from several stores involved it was determined the same person was responsible for over 1500 dollars' worth of credit card fraud. The suspect was located in the Stanwood area. After an interview the suspect provided a written confession. The case will be referred to the Snohomish County Prosecutor for charging.
