New World System

The following update was sent On October 28th by Kurt Mills, the Director of SNOPAC to Board Members and Agencies;

I'm pleased to report that the New World System (NWS) go-live has been a success. Yesterday over 4,000 users from 53 Law/Fire/EMS agencies, three jails and two 9-1-1 Centers cut over to the new system in a structured manner with systems coming on line smoothly and ahead of the day's schedule. The utilization of the Incident Management Team has proven immensely valuable in making sure we were positioned for success. NWS advises this was one of the smoothest, most organized cut-overs they have ever seen and owed the credit to the preparations by our county and agencies.

Our teams took a brief second to celebrate yesterday before shifting the focus back to supporting our agencies and users. The Super-SME's are holding daily pre-scheduled conference calls with agencies to provide pathways for addressing their needs. As we anticipated there's no shortage of minor issues, tweaks and configurations to work through. NWS has a large technical contingent here this week and will leave one senior tech with us for several additional days to track down straggling issues.

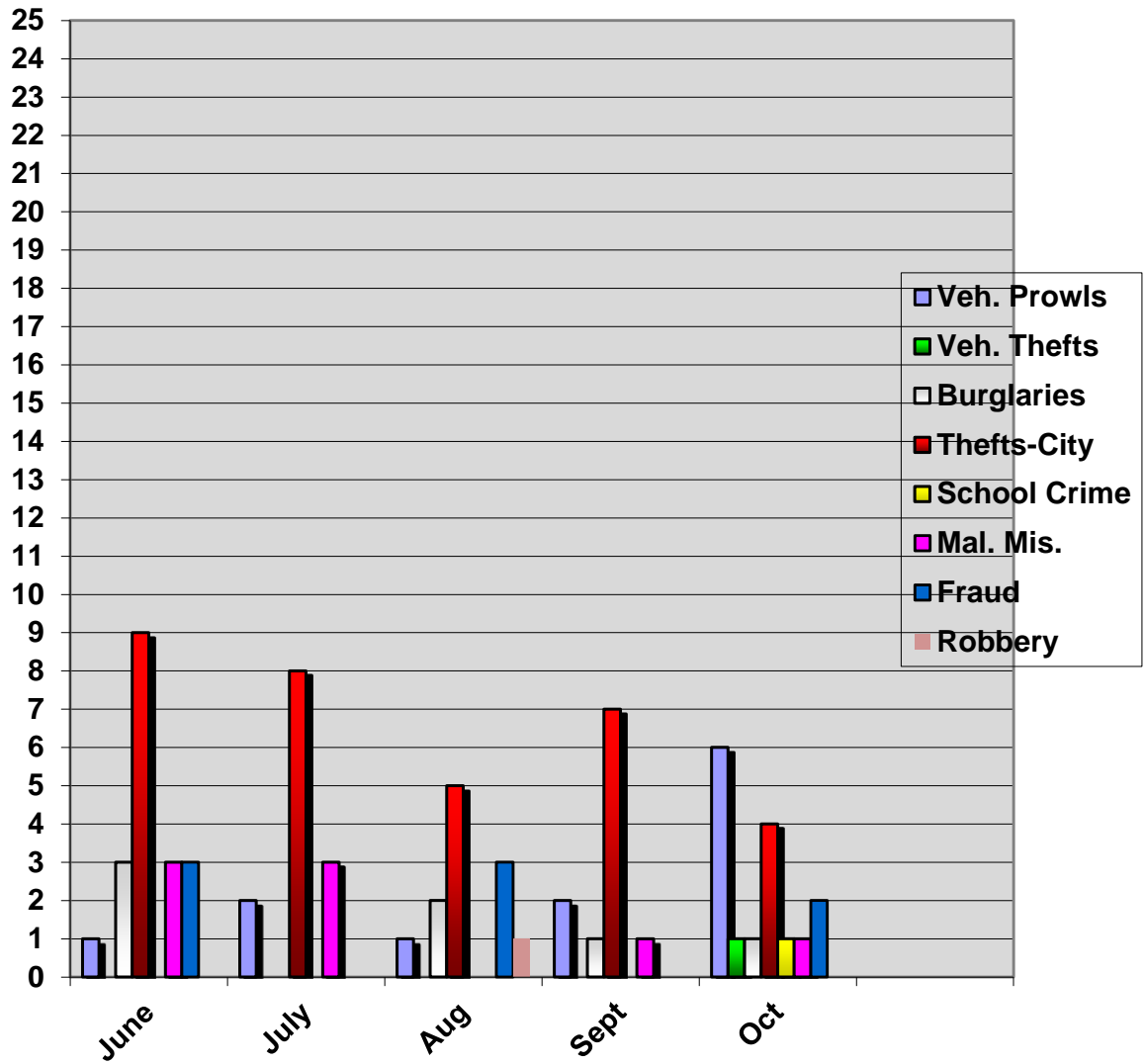

Detective Report – October 2015

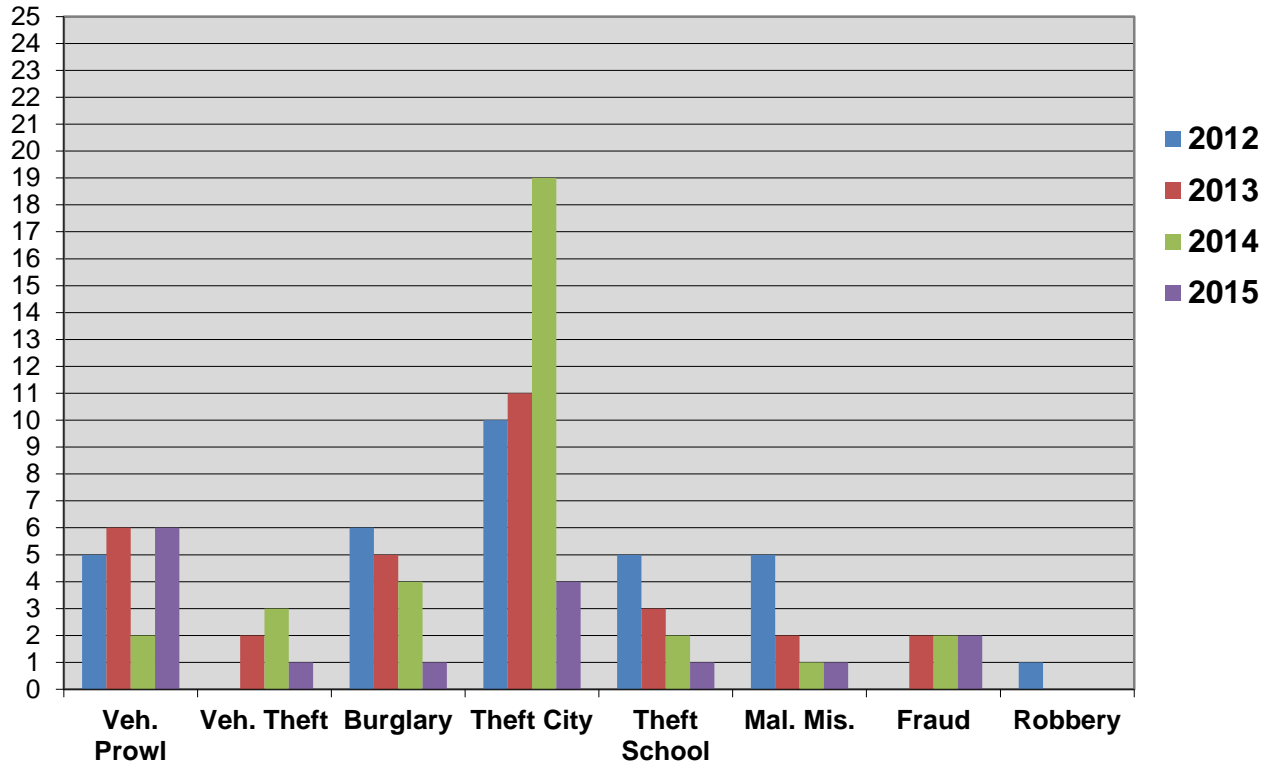
During the Month of October a Stanwood High School student received a threatening Instagram message. A search warrant was granted and served on Instagram which enabled both the school district technology department and the Police Department the ability to identify the sender who was also a student. It was determined the threat was not credible although other charges are pending.

Additional investigations include an assault between an adult male and juvenile male.
