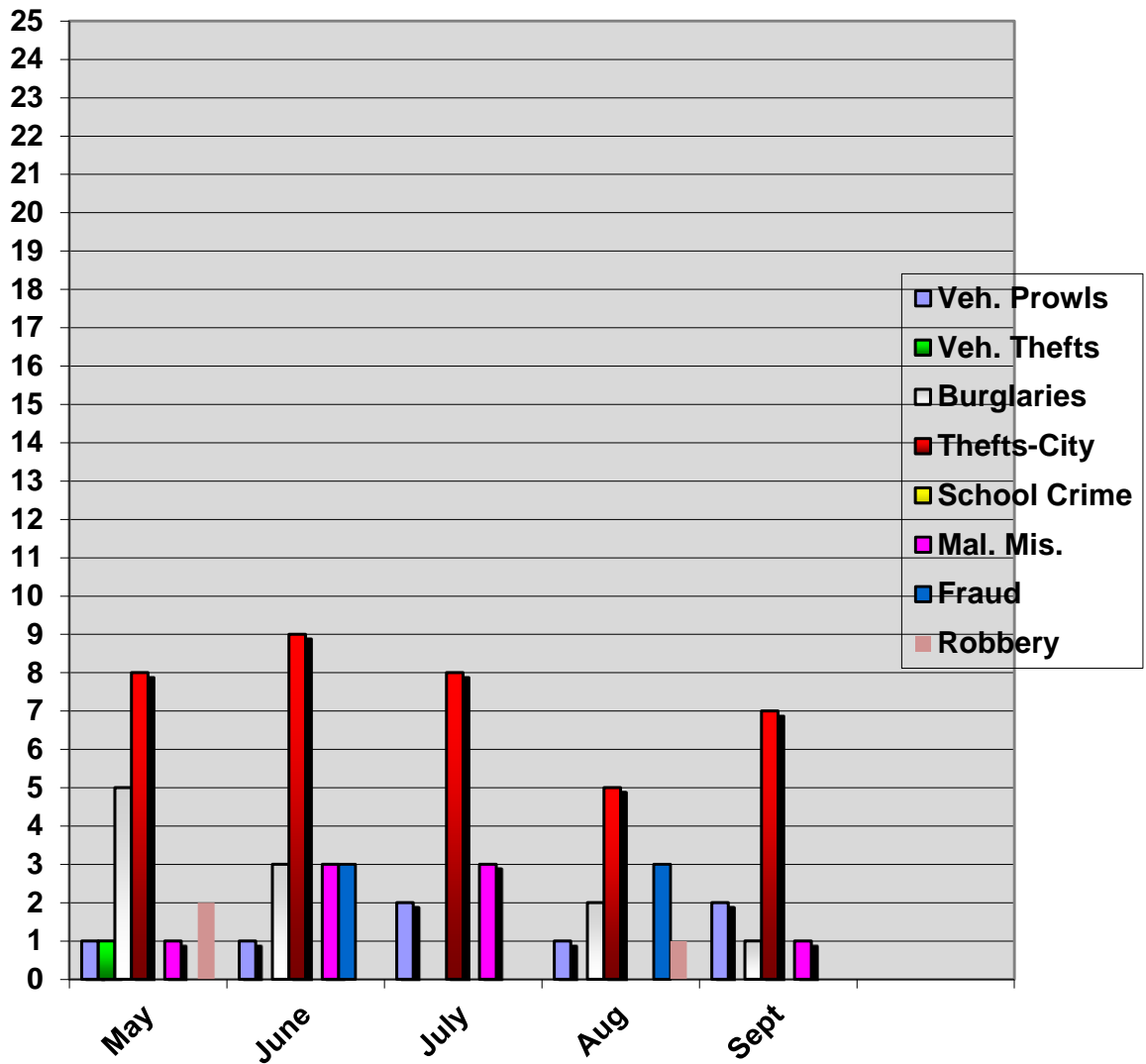
## **Detective Report – September 2015**

Reported crime in Stanwood for September was down overall

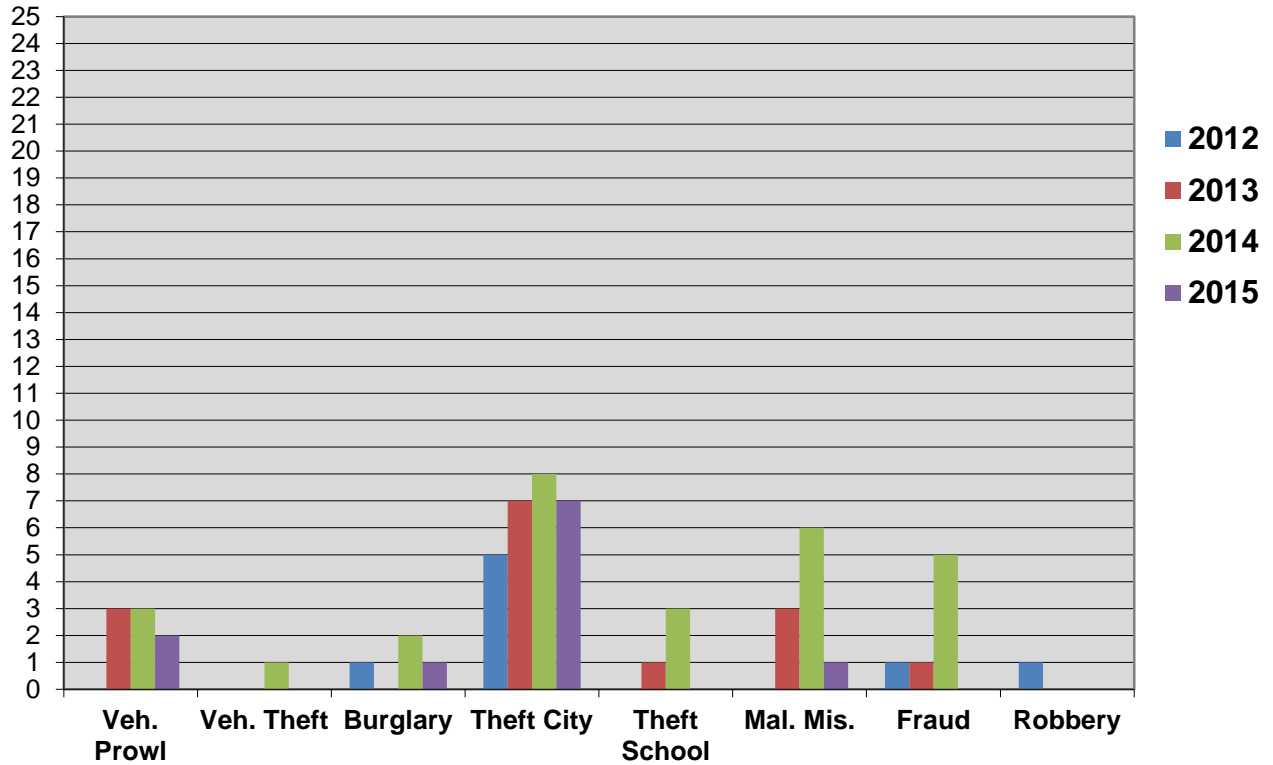
The earlier reported home invasion burglary has been closed. All charges have been referred. One male suspect has accepted a plea agreement to 3 years in prison. The remaining three subjects have charges pending.

The Burglary of a local lumber / hardware store which occurred last winter is now going through the courts. One of the two suspects in this case has pled guilty, the other is potentially facing more time and has chosen to take the case to trial. It is scheduled for the middle of Oct.
