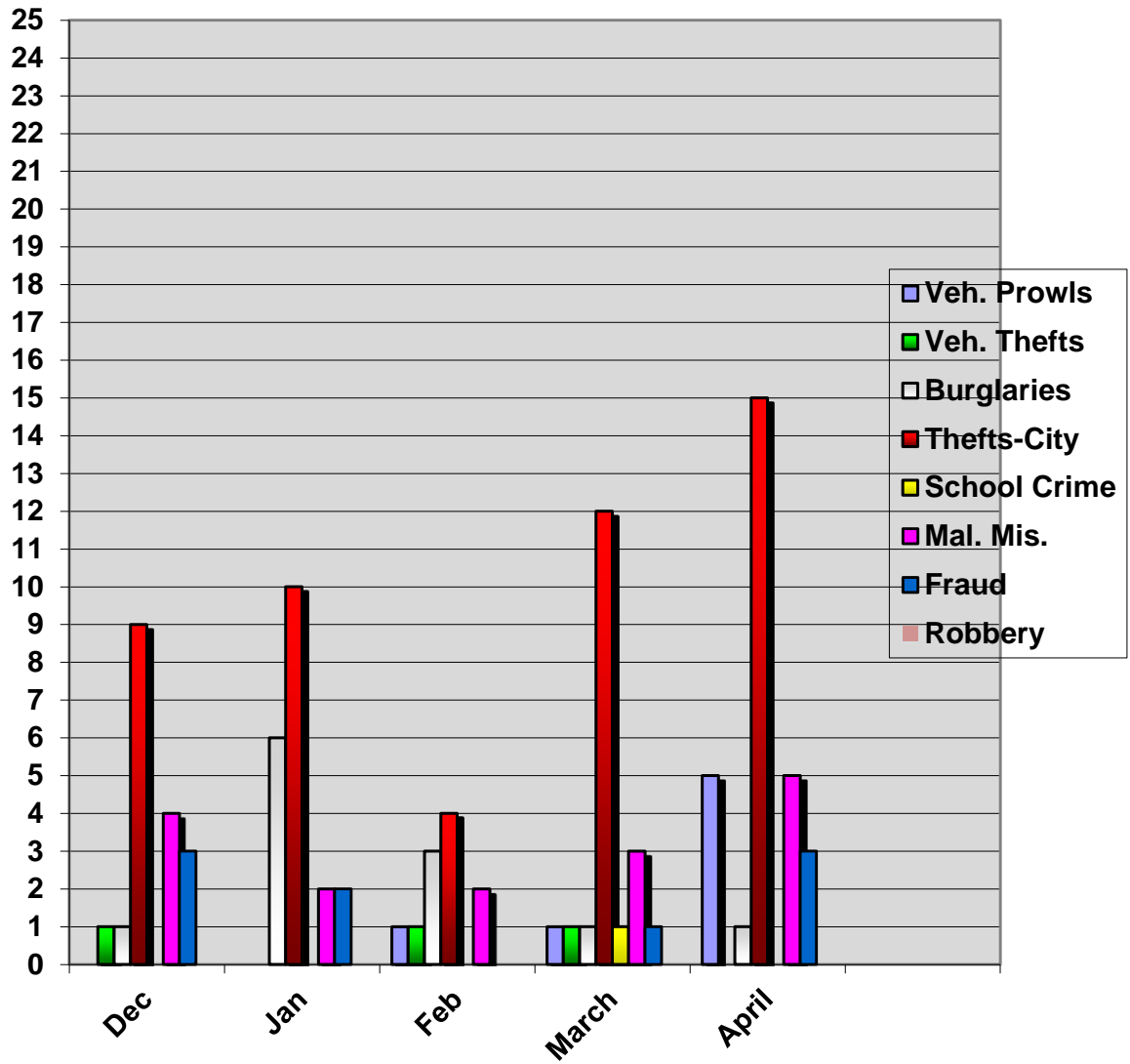
## **Detective Report – April 2015**

For the month of April, I along with a Detective from the Snohomish County Regional Drug Task Force have been investigating several people in and around Stanwood selling controlled substances such as Meth and Heroin. We have since made three arrests for delivery and expect to arrest five more.

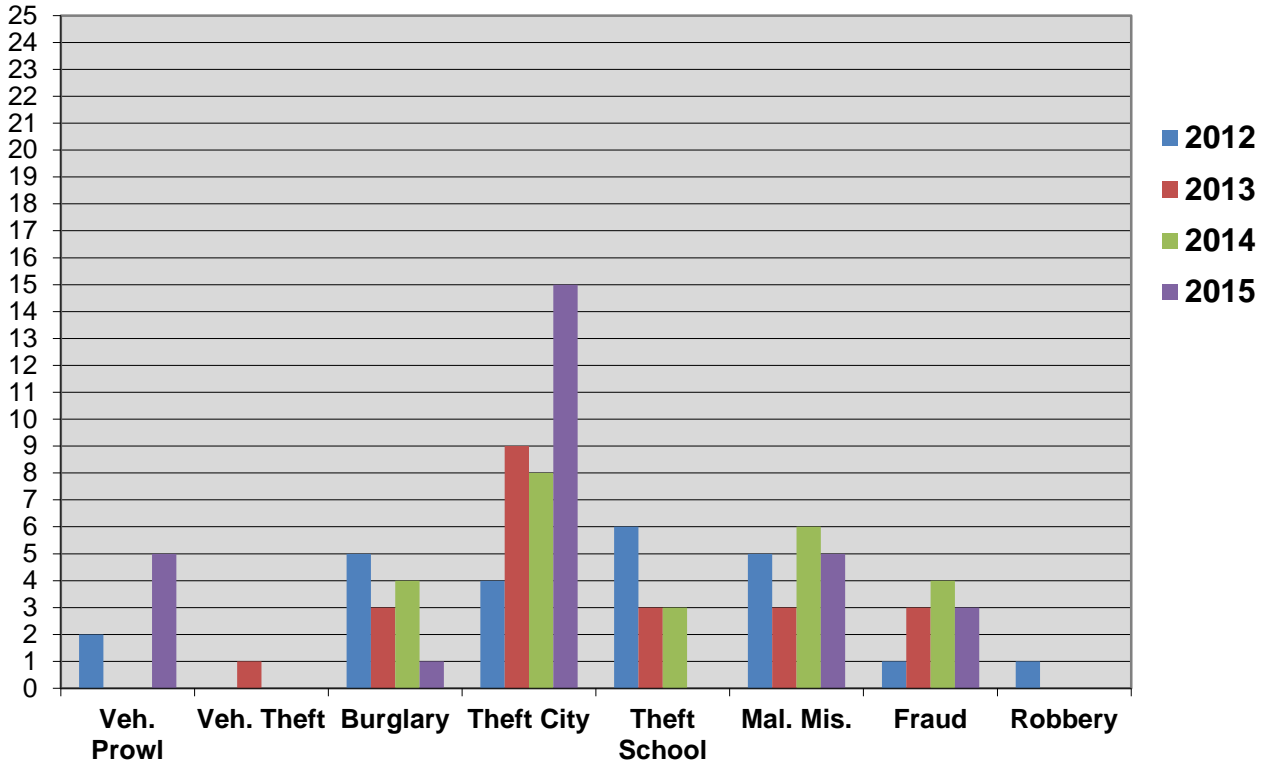
During the time of this report we have made one additional arrest related to this investigation. This person is a Meth Dealer who does deliveries in Stanwood but is living in the city of Arlington. He was arrested as he pulled into his driveway. His vehicle was seized and impounded pending a search warrant which will be served in the immediate future. I anticipate locating a large quantity of Meth inside his vehicle along with a large amount of cash. This individual's vehicle will be submitted for seizure to the Task Force.

I will keep you informed as to our progress on the remainder of our arrests as they happen or include you as needed.
