

Detective Report – December 2015

The month of December was a busy month. There was a noticeable increase in burglaries and vehicle prowls. Thanks to some great work by patrol a suspect in the vehicle prowls was contacted in the Hagggen's parking area after a shoplift incident. He matched the description of a suspect who had been confronted by victims earlier the same day in a vehicle prowl incident. After being questioned on scene by Officers he admitted to the other vehicle prowl incidents occurring in Stanwood. The suspects' vehicle was seized for a warrant. A warrant was served on the vehicle which resulted in the recovery of stolen property from several prior vehicle prowls. Charges were referred to the prosecutor's office.

Several burglaries were solved when Night shift responded to an in-progress report that building materials were being stolen from several residential units currently under construction. Deputy Liukko who was on duty that night arrived in the area within a minute of the original call. Deputy Liukko quickly located the suspect vehicle leaving the area with several of the items clearly visible in the back of the pickup truck. Additional units from the North Precinct responded and after a 7 mile slow speed pursuit and a short foot chase the suspect was taken into custody. Two additional passengers who were identified as co-defendants were also arrested. Most of the building materials were recovered and charges referred. I served a warrant on the vehicle to recover the stolen property and secure evidence. The stolen property was returned to the builder. The co-defendants confessed to the theft of the materials, implicating the driver as the primary person responsible for the thefts.
