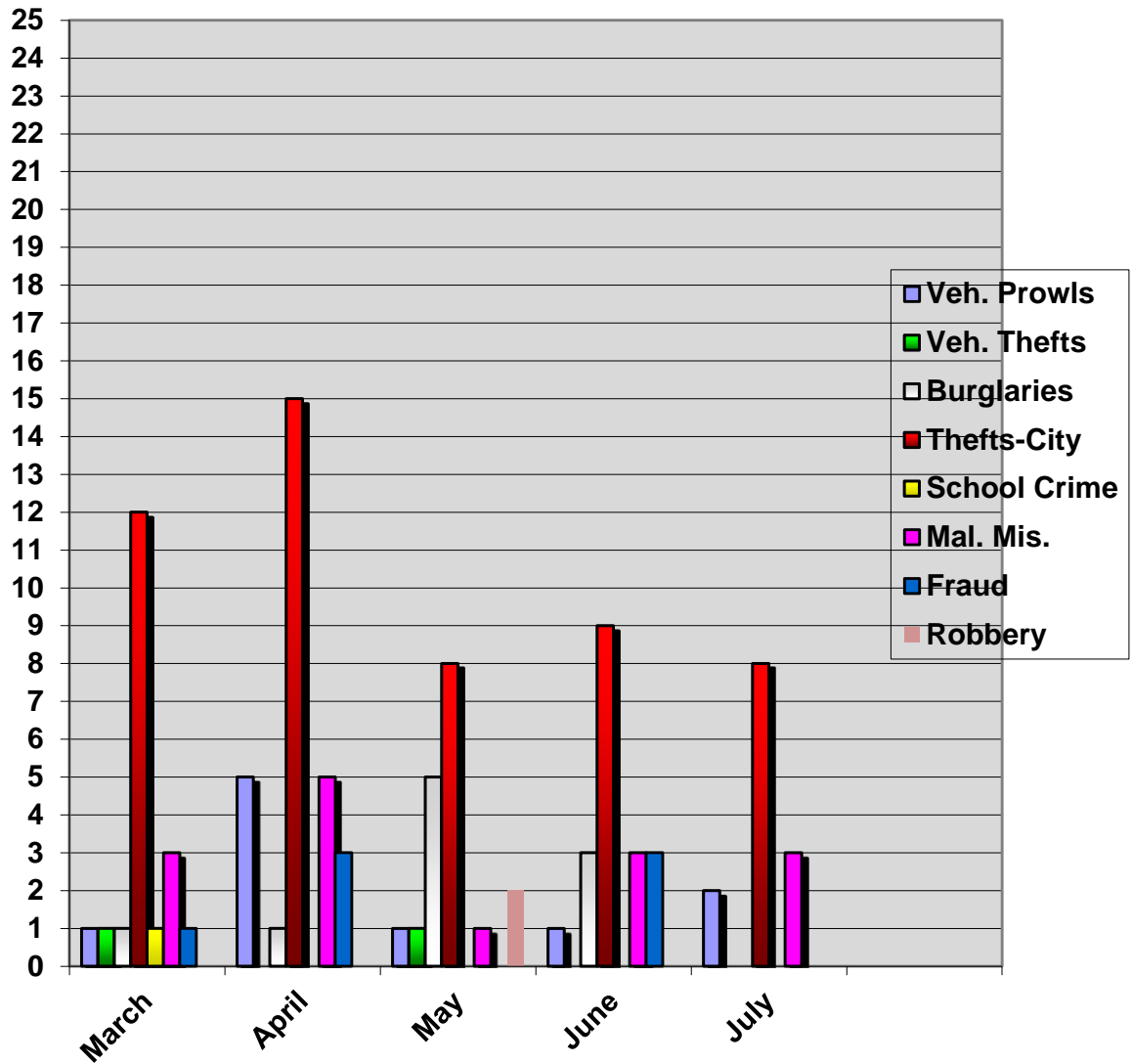
#### **Detective Report – July 2015**

During the month of July headway has been made in the Home Invasion Robbery which occurred in the month of May. All four individuals have been identified in this case. Two of the four suspects have been arrested. The male suspect is being held in our jail on \$500,000 dollar bail. The remaining two suspects have been referred to the Prosecutors Office for charging. I am waiting for arrest warrants to be issued.

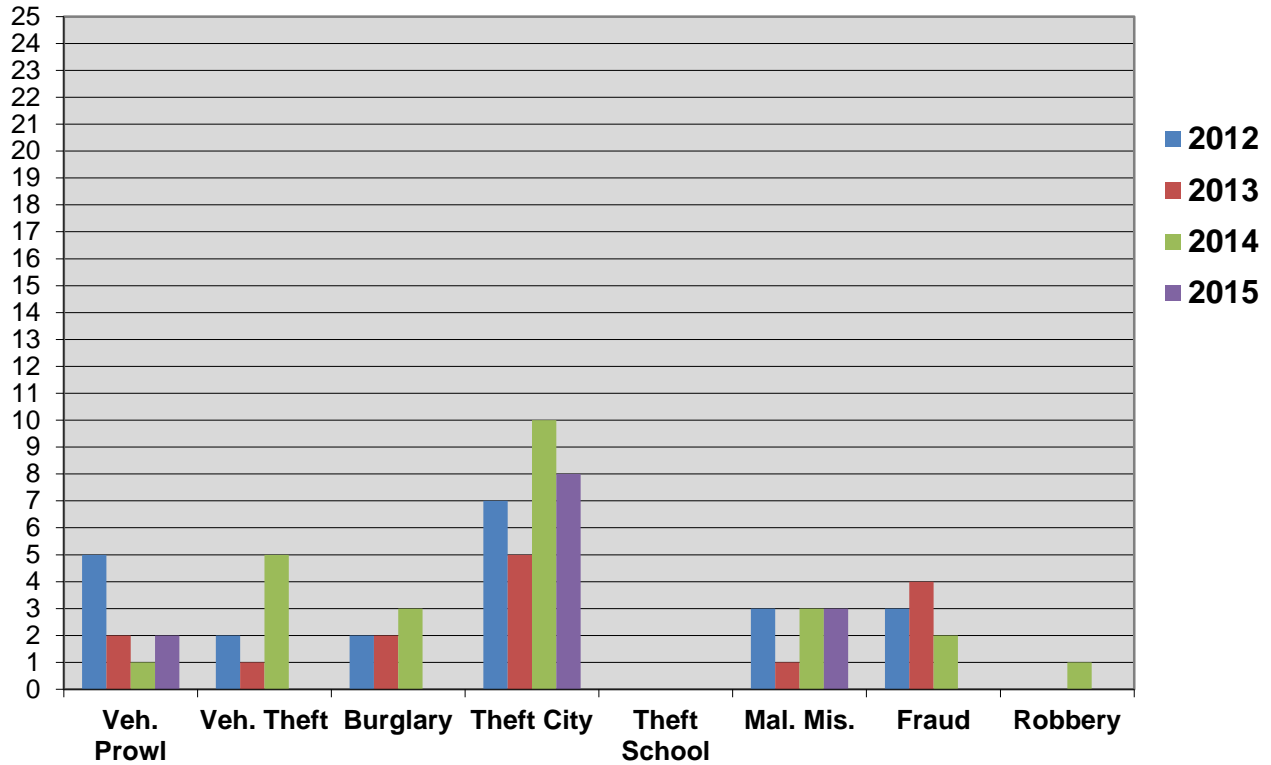
This crew of individuals is being linked to several burglaries in Kirkland and Bellevue areas to include trafficking in stolen weapons.

Additionally, Whatcom county had a similar incident which occurred only a few weeks after ours, involving an interrupted residential burglary/Robbery involving the same group.
