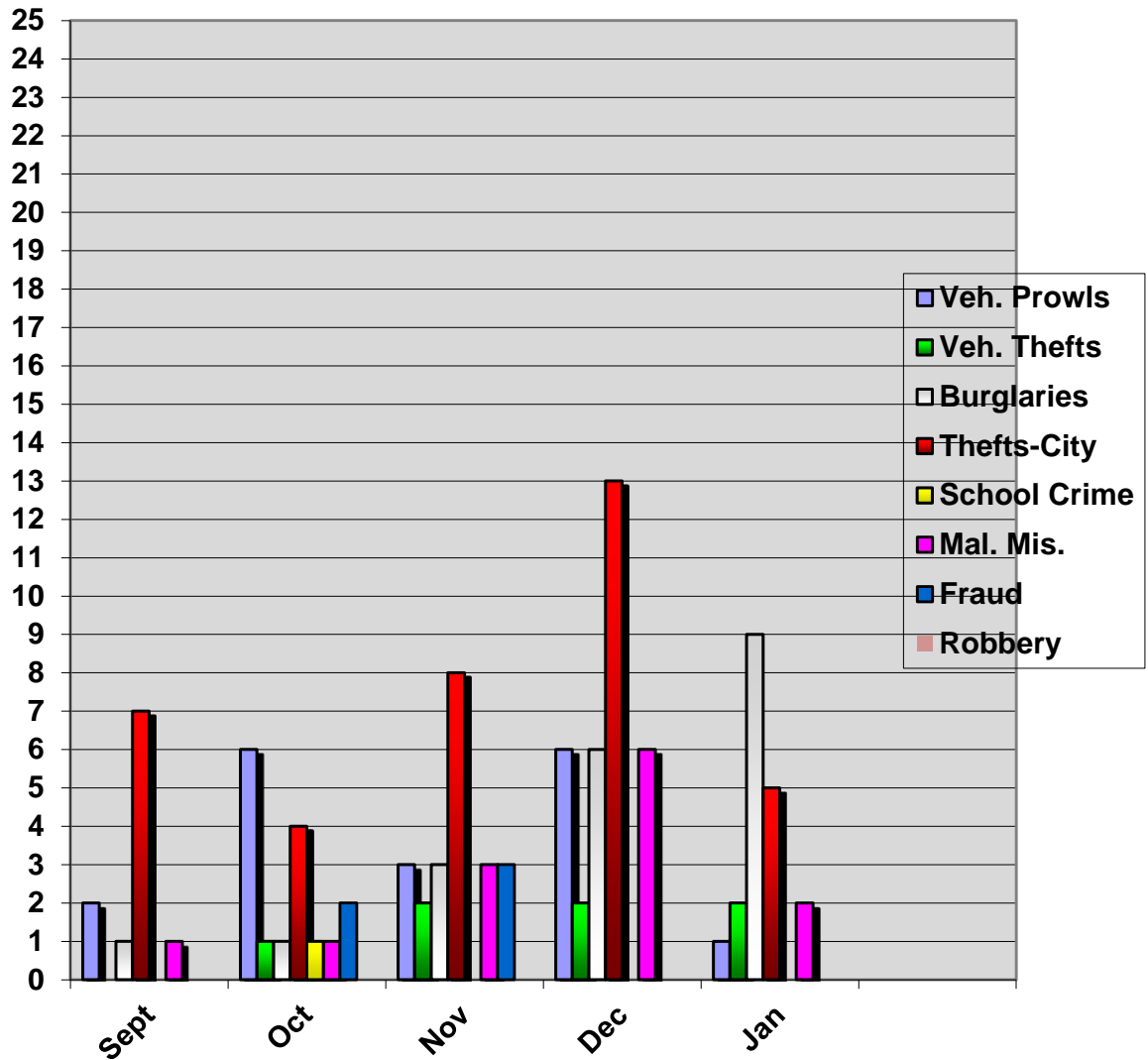
Detective Report – January 2016

The construction burglaries / thefts occurring within the Jasper Junction development have been solved and some of the property recovered. Three adult suspects have been referred to the prosecutor's office for Burglary 2nd.

The case involving the vehicle prowler at Josephine Sunset where the suspect took several credit cards from the purse of the victim then used them throughout the Mount Vernon and Burlington areas has also been identified and charges referred. I was able to identify the suspect in this case and met with him at the DOC Probation Office in Mount Vernon.

The last few months have been filled with Vehicle Prowls and Thefts. Two juvenile suspects were arrested in a stolen car by Lake Stevens Police. Both suspects were from the Stanwood Camano Island area. Stanwood Police took custody of the suspects and after further interviews the suspects led police to several locations within Stanwood where they had prowled several vehicles. Most of the vehicles prowled were left unlocked.
