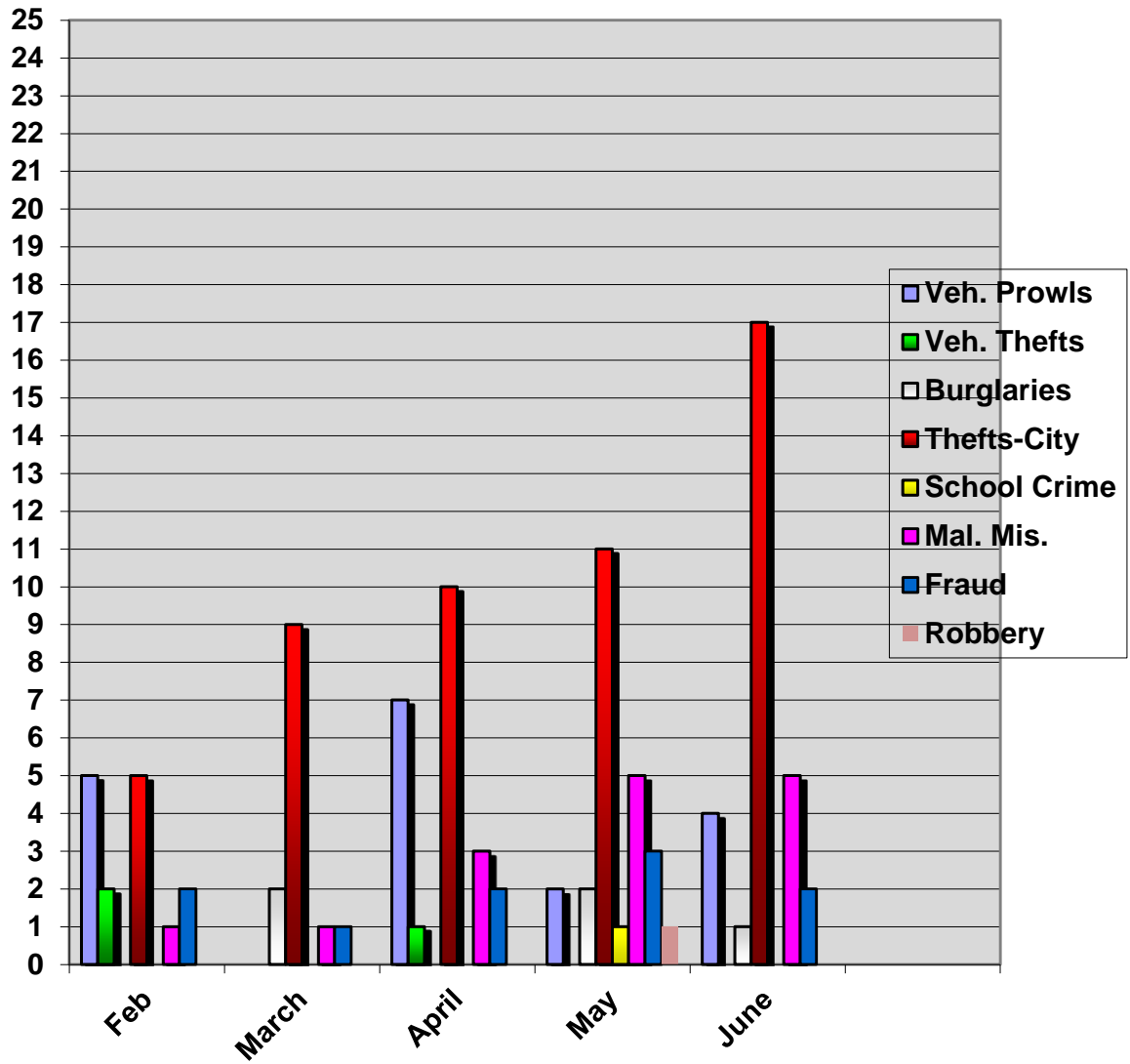

## **Detective Report – June 2016**

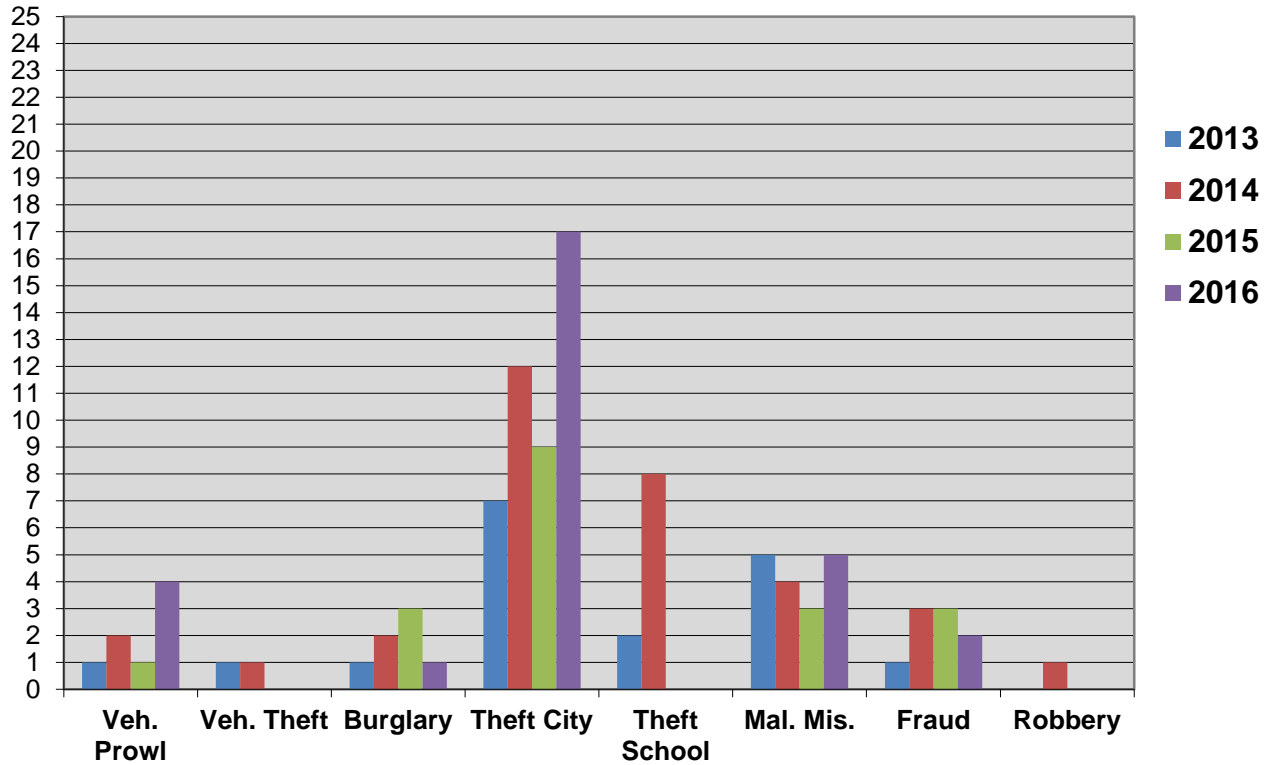
During the month of June Stanwood has experienced an increase in vehicle prowls and theft. Residents have been reminded to lock their vehicles.
