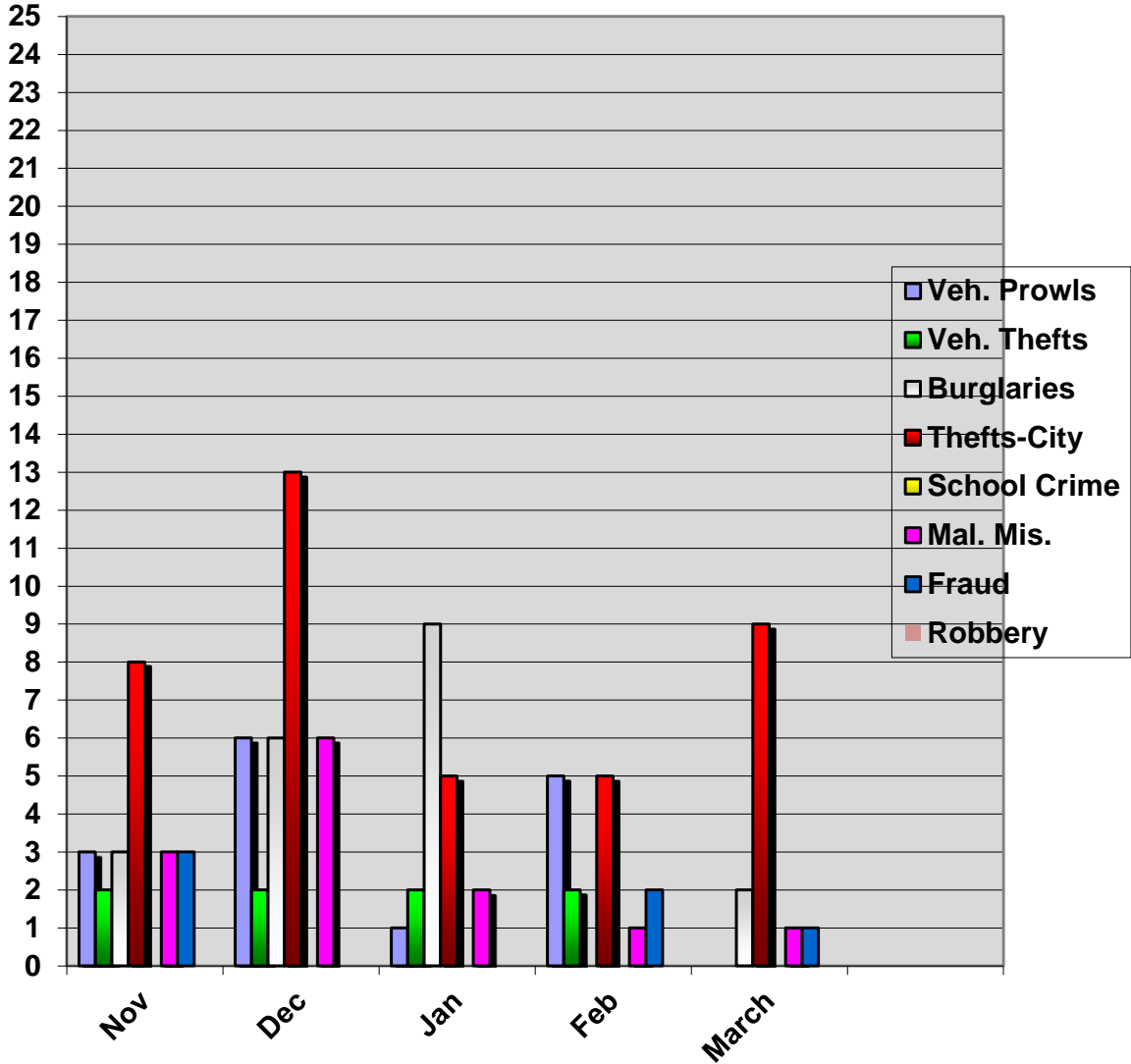

Detective Report – March 2016

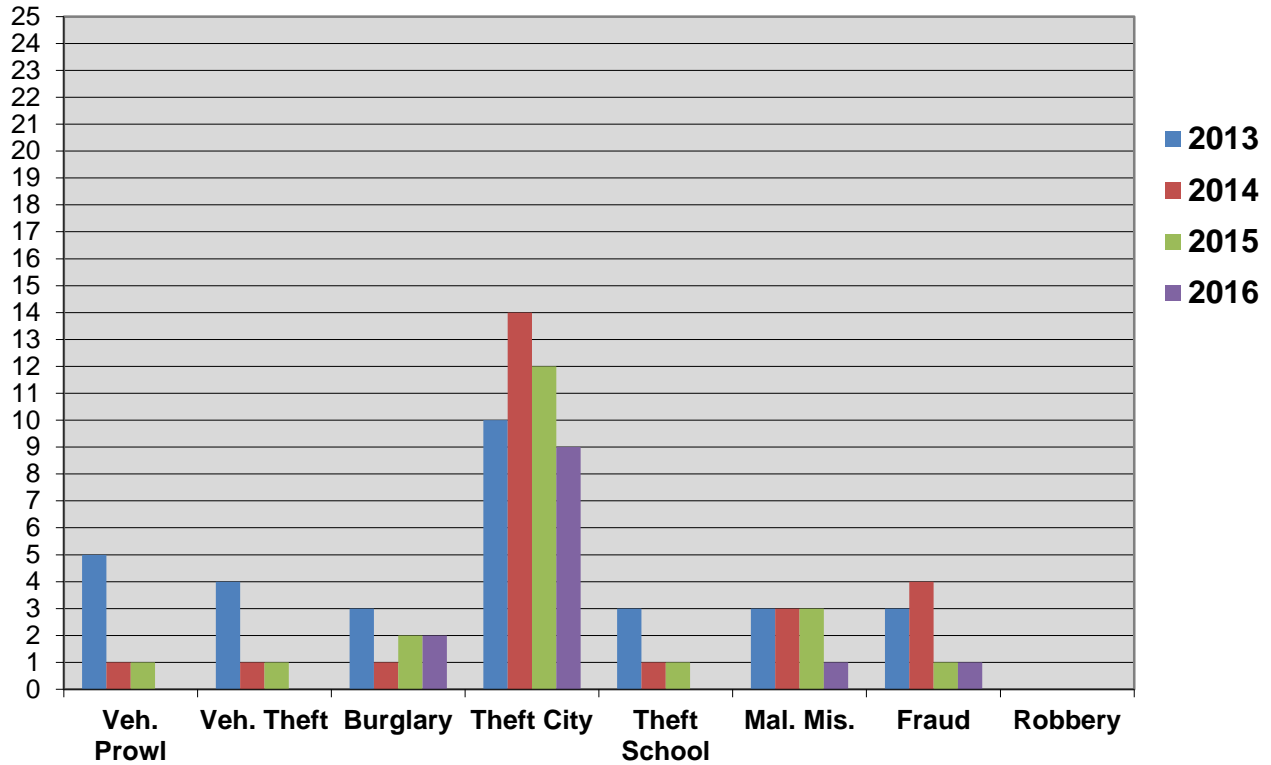
I have been working a counterfeit case this month involving two incidents in Stanwood. Thanks to some help by Dep Liukko I put together a photo montage which identified the individual responsible. Using this name I conducted a state wide search and discovered this individual was picked up in the city of Palouse with approx. 3500.00 dollars in counterfeit 100.00 dollar bills. He had been printing the bills on a printer recovered in the trunk of the car by Palouse PD. Palouse contacted the Secret Service out of Spokane who conducted the interview. The suspect confessed to several incidents in Washington State. I contacted the Secret Service Agent who had done the interview and after talking with him he agreed it might be best to approach the Federal Prosecutor to possibly consolidate the cases in Washington. The suspect lives in the Burlington area so I coordinated with Mount Vernon PD, Sedro Woolley and Burlington to obtain their cases as well. I additionally put out a memo State wide in addition to the Gambling Commission notification in an effort to obtain all the cases in the state dealing with this particular suspect. The Stanwood case has been referred to the Prosecutors office with this information.

I also recently worked an Arson case which occurred at Lincoln Hill HS in Stanwood. Thanks to an outstanding team effort by everyone involved including the Fire Marshal the suspect in this case was identified via video. After several days of work the suspect was contacted and interviewed who confessed to the arson. The suspect was booked into jail for Arson first degree.
