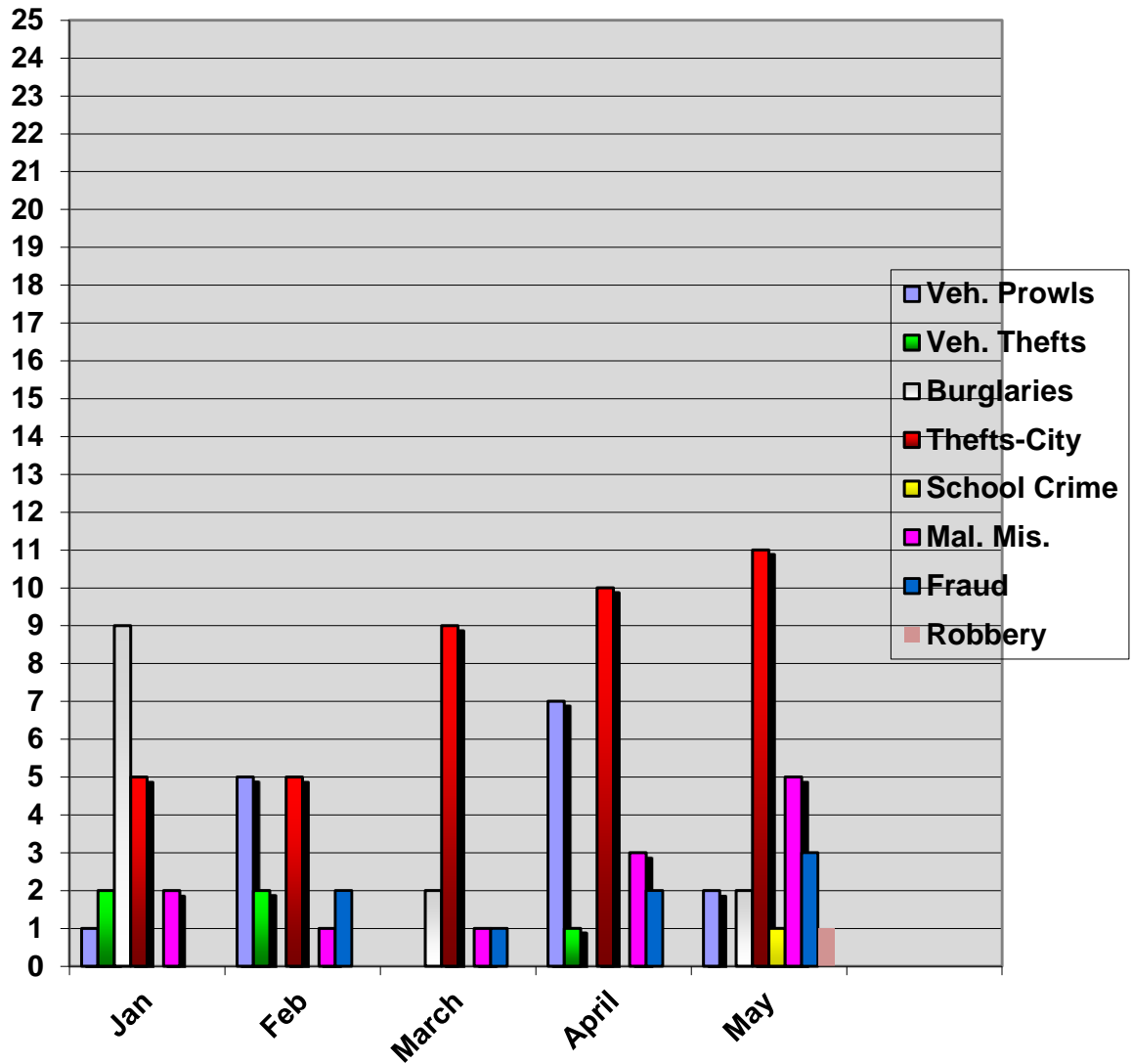

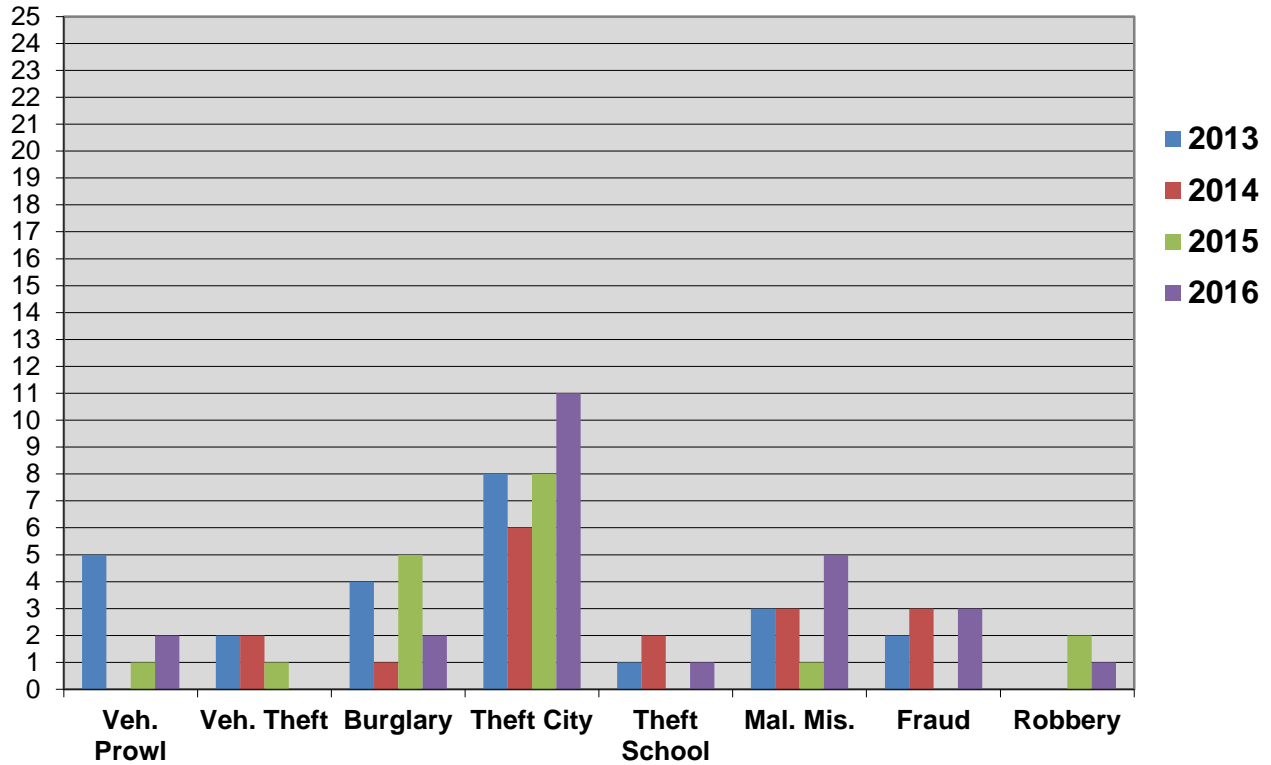
Detective Report – May 2016
