## **Chiefs Notes:**

Back in 2012 when I first began working in Stanwood I noticed Church Creek Park was closed daily during the school year. I was told this was done because of continuous vandalism and drug use in the park. It was sad to see such a nice facility be closed to the public because of a few that refuse to respect public property. To me, closing the park just because of a few delinquents was not acceptable.

Since that time we have opened the park. I believe in order to solve the problems at the park it would take more than just law enforcement. We focused on three areas. The first required communicating with those who frequent the park. This resulted in a mural being painted which is done yearly by several youth who frequent the park. The mural provided some ownership. The second part included cleaning up the park which Public Works has done with help from volunteers. The third approach is law enforcement to include more visibility, talking to those who use the park and arresting those who violate the rules.

The park began seeing additional use to include Frisbee golf. We still experienced some vandalism and drug issues although over time we have seen some improvement. This year there have been minimal incidents up until May 5, 2016 when the restrooms were badly damaged. Damage estimates came to approximately \$1,800. Deputy Willoth took the initial complaint and after some good detective work she was able to identify two juvenile suspects that were responsible.

Since that incident we have experienced graffiti damage to the tables and playground slide. This sudden increase in vandalism is a significant setback to what we hoped to accomplish. We will continue our focus and attempt to hold those responsible accountable.

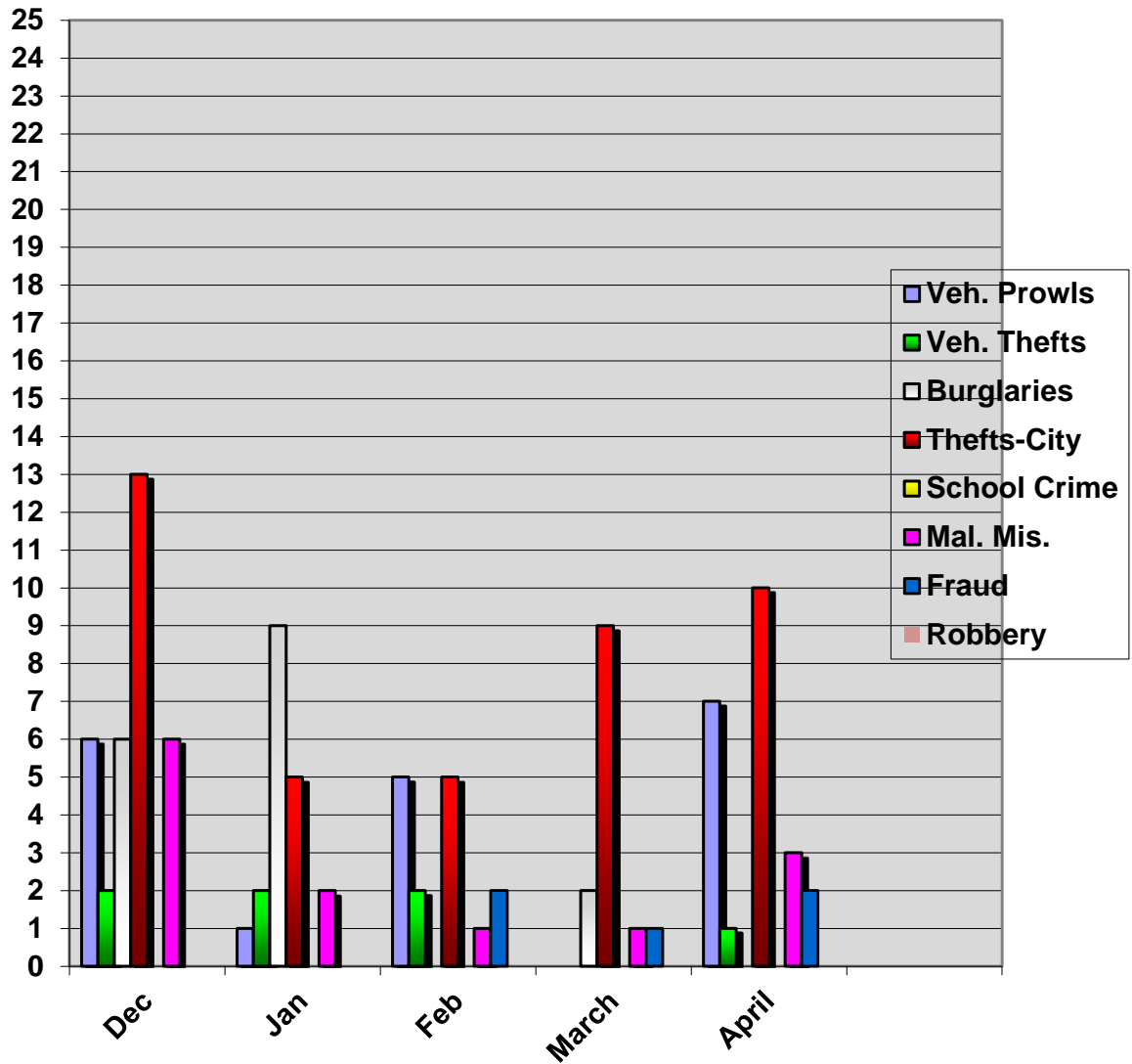

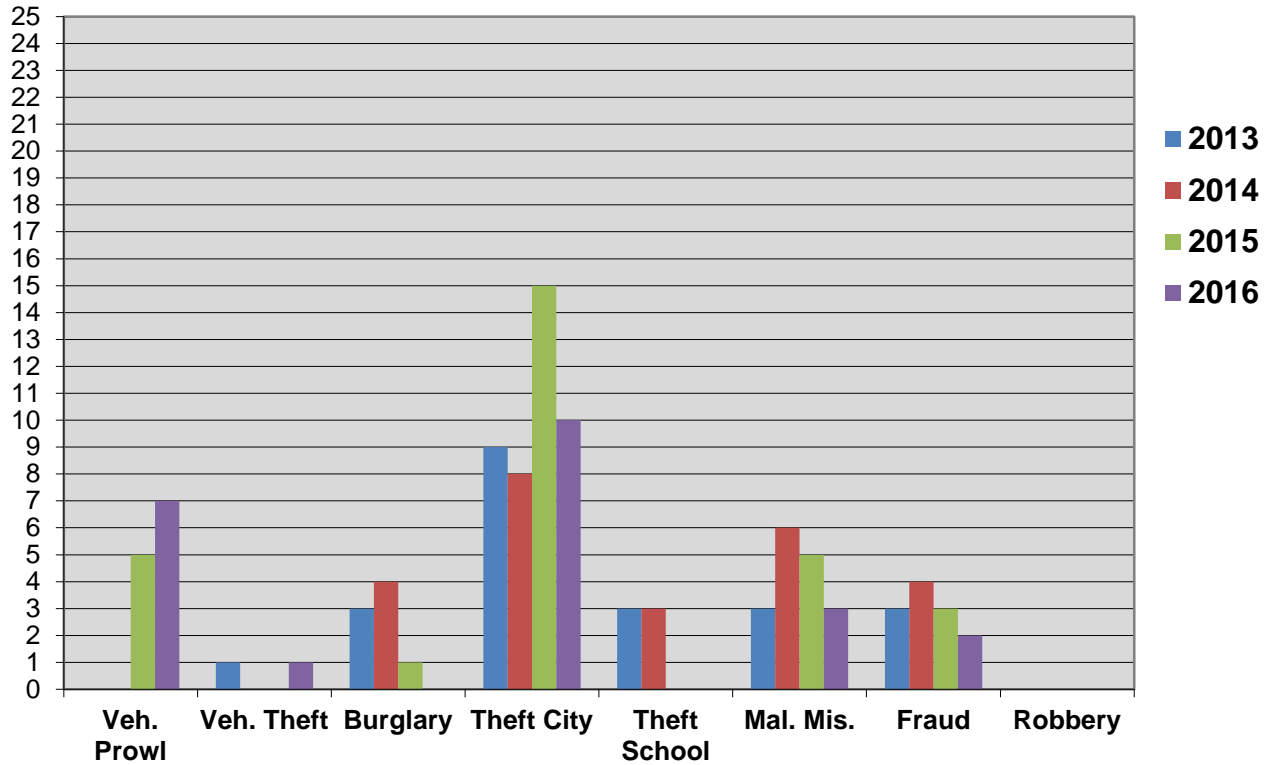
## **Detective Report – April 2016**
