### **Stanwood Case 2020-3188 Burglary/Mill Creek Police Case Burglary Update-Same Suspect**

On 04-28-2020 Deputy Scott responded to a report of a theft from a secured area of the Country Store. The store manager reported a lawn mower stolen from inside a fenced area while the store was closed.

The subject was identified and arrested in Stanwood on 04-30-2020.

The Mill Creek Police Department developed probable cause for the subject's arrest related to his alleged involvement in a burglary at a McDonald's in their City.

The subject was arrested a second time by Stanwood deputies and booked into the Snohomish County Jail on Mill Creek's burglary charge. The subject's vehicle was seized after deputies observed what appeared to be illegal drugs inside.

On 05-28-2020 Sgt. Toner obtained a search warrant for the vehicle. Sgt. Toner seized a small amount of drugs suspected to be heroin and methamphetamine during the search. Charges are being referred to the Prosecutor's Office.

### **Stanwood Case 2020-3016 Update Identity Theft**



On 04-21-2020 Deputy Scott responded to a theft complaint and learned the victim's wallet had been stolen from the QFC store on 04-03-2020. The victim decided to report the theft after discovering fraudulent charges on one of his credit cards.

Several citizens responded to images of the suspect posted on the Stanwood Police Department Facebook page identifying the male as a Camano Island resident.

The subject was arrested in Stanwood on 05-26-2020 and booked into the Snohomish County Jail on the charge of Identity Theft Second Degree.
