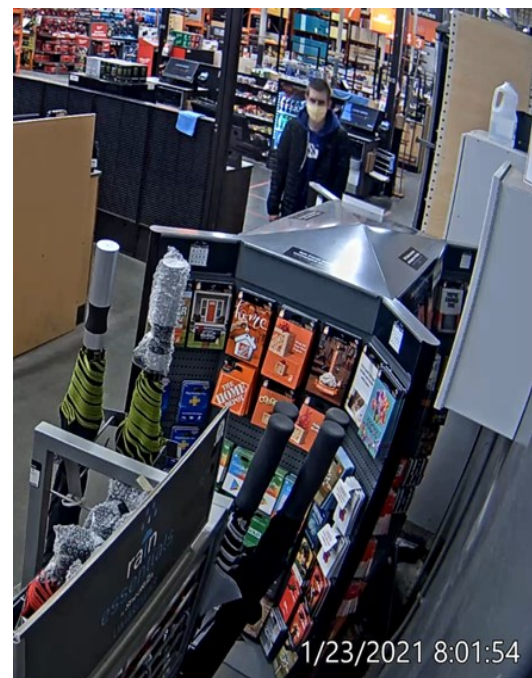


Stanwood Case 2021-0562 Vehicle Prowl/Identity Theft

On 01-23-2021 Deputy Scott responded to a vehicle prowling complaint and learned the victim's wallet was stolen from a vehicle in her garage sometime during the evening of 01-22-2021. The victim left her car unlocked and her garage door open overnight. The following morning the victim received notification from her credit card account provider of fraudulent activity at various retail locations in the Seattle area.

Detective Martin collected video from four retail locations in Seattle and discovered two male subjects associated with the unauthorized use of the victim's credit cards. One of the subjects was identified by asset protection associates as a resident of Seattle in the Northgate area.

Detective Martin will attempt contact with the known subject and attempt to identify the other person involved.





Stanwood Case 20210745 Theft

On 01-30-2021 Deputy Skidmore responded to a theft from a store in Stanwood. A store employee reported a male and female subject taking several hundred dollars of Carhart clothing, before fleeing the parking lot in their car.

The store manager reported a similar theft from the same business in Sedro Woolley on 12-16-2020. Detective Martin will be working with the Sedro Woolley Police Department to identify possible suspects.
