**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF STANWOOD,
SNOHOMISH COUNTY, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING THE
NON-MOTORIZED TRANSPORTATION PLAN.**

WHEREAS, the City of Stanwood held an open house style public meeting on October 29, 2015 to kick off the project and invite feedback regarding the upcoming process; and

WHEREAS, the City of Stanwood formed a citizen advisory committee in January 2016 to assist the city with development of the Plan; and

WHEREAS, citizen advisory committee met four times including conducting a field tour of the city; and

WHEREAS, the city hosted two community workshops on April 28, 2016 and June 30, 2016 to get community input; and

WHEREAS, the city conducted a pedestrian and bicycle user survey to yield a broad representation of community insight; and

WHEREAS, more than 260 community members provided comments and suggestions which were considered for the Plan; and

WHEREAS, the council public works committee reviewed progress on the Plan at its November and December 2015 meetings and its February, April, June, July, September and October 2016 meetings; and

WHEREAS, the council public works committee recommended at the October 10, 2016 meeting that the city council adopt the Plan; and

WHEREAS, the planning commission reviewed progress on the Plan at its July and October 2016 meetings; and


WHEREAS, the planning commission recommended at the October 10, 2016 meeting that the city council adopt the Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STANWOOD AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. That the Non-Motorized Transportation Plan and Appendices, a true copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein, is hereby adopted.


