RESOLUTION NO. 2007-5

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF STANWOOD DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST AND AUTHORIZING AN EMERGENCY WORKS CONTRACT FOR THE REPAIR AND RESTORATION OF HATT SLOUGH WATER MAIN CROSSING OF THE STILLAGUAMISH RIVER, STANWOOD, WASHINGTON.

WHEREAS, The Hatt Slough Water Main Crossing of the Stillaguamish River was installed in 1984. The piping materials used for the Crossing was steel pipe and offered no corrosion protection, and the City is experiencing numerous leaks in the crossing causing damage, and further damage and risk will occur if immediate repair work is not commenced; and

WHEREAS, the planned repair is to use a polyester reinforced lining system which will solve the corrosion and prevent further leakage and damage; and


WHEREAS, the public health, safety and welfare of the City's citizens and utility customers may be jeopardized due to the City's inability to stop the leaks and provide water service in this vital part of the water distribution system which is a primary source of water supply to the utility customers and citizens of Stanwood;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STANWOOD, WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:

1. An emergency exists, and property or persons within the City would suffer material injury or damage by delay, and the public health, safety and welfare would suffer material injury or damage by delay, and such emergency is now hereby proclaimed.
2. The existence of such emergency, and the facts constituting the emergency, are set out in the recital paragraphs of this Resolution.
3. The City Council does hereby waive the requirements of RCW 35A.40.210(2) and RCW 35.23.352 requiring public bidding to contract for repair and restoration of the Hatt Slough Water Main Crossing at the Stillaguamish River.
4. The City Council has authorized the Mayor to enter into an emergency work contract with a qualified contractor to repair the damage and to appropriately repair and restore the Hatt Slough Water Main Crossing at the Stillaguamish River.


