

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-3

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF STANWOOD, WASHINGTON DECLARING CERTAIN PROPERTY TO BE SURPLUS TO THE NEEDS OF THE CITY AND AUTHORIZING THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO ARRANGE FOR AND TO EXECUTE THE SALE OF SAID PROPERTY FOR THE COMMON BENEFIT, SUBJECT TO CITY COUNCIL APPROVAL.

WHEREAS, the City of Stanwood owns a house located at 10306 270th Street NW, Stanwood, Washington, which is surplus to the needs of the City and is not required for providing continued municipal services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Stanwood will consider the house personal property when it is severed from the foundation or dismantled; and

WHEREAS, the City of Stanwood has decided that the house has no current value or negative value to the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to declare such property surplus and to authorize the Finance Director to market and arrange for the sale of said property by the most efficient means;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STANWOOD DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The City Council hereby determines and finds that certain property described above is surplus to the needs of the City and is not required for providing continued municipal service.

Section 2. The Finance Director is authorized to use whatever means she deems most reasonable to market the surplus property to accomplish the sale thereof.

Section 3. The Surplus Property described above shall be sold subject to entry into a purchase and sale agreement approved by the City Council.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STANWOOD:


