

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-5

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF STANWOOD, WASHINGTON DECLARING CERTAIN PROPERTY TO BE SURPLUS TO THE NEEDS OF THE CITY AND AUTHORIZING THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO ARRANGE FOR AND TO EXECUTE THE SALE OF SAID PROPERTY IN A MANNER THAT IN HER JUDGMENT WILL NET THE GREATEST AMOUNT FOR THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the City of Stanwood owns certain used equipment and tools which are surplus to the needs of the City and are not required for providing continued municipal services; and

WHEREAS, RCW 35.94.040 requires that a public hearing be held if the equipment was originally acquired for public utility purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to declare such property surplus and to authorize the Finance Director to arrange for and to execute the sale of said property in a manner that in her judgment will net the greatest amount for the City;


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STANWOOD DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby determines and finds that certain property described in Attachment A is surplus to the needs of the City and is not required for providing continued municipal service.

Section 2. The Finance Director is authorized to arrange for and to execute the sale of said property in a manner that in her judgment will net the greatest amount for the City.
