

RESOLUTION 2010-8

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF STANWOOD, WASHINGTON ADOPTING THE
COMPREHENSIVE WATER SYSTEM PLAN**

WHEREAS, under WAC 246-290-100, the City is required to update its water system plan every six years with the Washington State Department of Health; and

WHEREAS, the City is proposing to adopt a Comprehensive Water System Plan and to identify and schedule water system improvements that correct existing system deficiencies consistent with the Plan; and

WHEREAS, a SEPA checklist was prepared on October 9, 2009 and a Determination of Non-significance was issued on October 16, 2009; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on August 26, 2010 and a City Council Workshop was held on July 29, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the Comprehensive Water System Plan is necessary to ensure a safe and reliable supply of water to current and future customers; and


WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Water System Plan complies with the Washington State Department of Health regulations under WAC 246-290-100, requiring purveyors to update their water system plans every six years,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STANWOOD WASHINGTON DOES HEREBY:

Adopt the Comprehensive Water System Plan dated September 9, 2010 and attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.


