RESOLUTION NO. 2012-2

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF STANWOOD DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST AND AUTHORIZING EMERGENCY WORKS CONTRACTS FOR THE REPAIR AND RESTORATION OF SEWER FORCE MAIN/PUMP STATION AND REQUIRED CLEAN UP.

WHEREAS, as a result of circumstances still under investigation the City's main sewer force main and Pump Station on 94th Drive failed on April 25, 2012 causing the discharge of raw, untreated waste water, with the risk of further damage if immediate repair work, restoration and clean-up is not commenced; and

WHEREAS, the failure of the pump station and/or sewer force main creates an emergency, which requires immediate remediation, or the City's ability to provide waste water collection is impaired; and


WHEREAS, the public health, safety and welfare of the City's customers, residents and property owners may be jeopardized due to this failure;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STANWOOD, WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:

1. An emergency exists, and property or persons within the City would suffer material injury or damage by delay, and the public health, safety and welfare would suffer material injury or damage by delay, and such emergency is now hereby proclaimed.
2. The existence of such emergency, and the facts constituting the emergency, are set out in the recital paragraphs of this Resolution.
3. The City Council does hereby waive the requirements of RCW 35A.40.210(2) and RCW 35.23.352 requiring public bidding to contract for repair, restoration and clean up associated with the failure of the pump station and sewer force main on 94th Drive.
4. The City Council directs Staff to enter into emergency work contracts to repair the damage and to appropriately repair and restore, clean up for the failure of the force main and pump station. The Mayor is authorized to enter into appropriate emergency works contracts with qualified contractors for said emergency work.

PASSED by the City Council and APPROVED by the Mayor this 26th day of April, 2012.


