RESOLUTION 2013-14**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF STANWOOD, WASHINGTON DECLARING ENGINE 99A AND SEVENTEEN (17) SETS OF MSA AIR PACKS, THIRTEEN (13) EXTRA MASKS AND TWO (2) RIT PACKS TO BE SURPLUS TO THE NEEDS OF THE CITY AND AUTHORIZING THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO ARRANGE FOR AND TO EXECUTE THE SALE AND/OR DISPOSAL OF SAID PROPERTY FOR THE COMMON BENEFIT, SUBJECT TO THE CITY COUNCIL APPROVAL.

WHEREAS, The City of Stanwood owns Engine 99A, MSA air packs, masks and RIT packs which are surplus to the needs of the City and are not required for providing continued municipal services; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to declare such property surplus and to authorize the Finance Director to arrange for and to execute the sale and/or disposal of said property by the most efficient means;


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STANWOOD DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby determines and finds that Engine 99A, MSA air packs, masks and RIT packs are surplus to the needs of the City and are not required for providing continued municipal service.


Section 2. The Finance Director is authorized to arrange for and execute the sale and/or disposal of said property by the most efficient means.
