

ORDINANCE NO. 1496

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF STANWOOD, WASHINGTON
REPEALING CHAPTER 2.52 OF THE STANWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE**

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City Council to maintain the Stanwood Municipal Code in a manner which keeps it current with city administrative policy and procedures; and

WHEREAS, Stanwood voters approved annexation into the Sno Isle Library District in 2015 and duties of the Library Board of Trustees have changed since its inception are no longer required; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to amend SMC Title 2 to correspond with the facts represented in the aforementioned recitals.

**NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STANWOOD DO
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. SMC Title 2 Amended. SMC Title 2 is hereby amended as presented in the underline and strikethrough font in Attachment A.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

ADMINISTRATION AND PERSONNEL

Chapter 2.52
BOARD OF LIBRARY TRUSTEES

2.52.010 Establishment.

There shall be a board of library trustees for the city as provided by Chapter [27.12](#) RCW. The board shall consist of five trustees who shall be appointed by the mayor with the consent of the council.

(Ord. 1134 § 1, 2003; Ord. 402 § 1, 1973).

2.52.020 Term.

The term of each library trustee shall be five years. The term of each trustee shall commence on January 1st, and terminate on December 31st, of the fifth year thereafter. The city clerk shall maintain an accurate record of the appointment and tenure of each trustee. No person shall be appointed to the board for more than two consecutive terms. (Ord. 1134 § 1, 2003; Ord. 402 § 2, 1973).

2.52.030 Organization.

The trustees at the first meeting of each calendar year shall meet and organize by the election of such officers as they deem necessary. (Ord. 1134 § 1, 2003; Ord. 402 § 3, 1973).

2.52.040 Vacancies.

Vacancies shall be filled for unexpired terms as soon as possible in the manner in which members of the board are chosen. (Ord. 1134 § 1, 2003; Ord. 402 § 4, 1973).

2.52.050 Compensation.

Repealed by Ord. 1134. (Ord. 402 § 5, 1973).

2.52.060 Removal.

A library trustee may be removed only by majority vote of the entire city council. (Ord. 1134 § 1, 2003; Ord. 402 § 6, 1973).

2.52.070 Duties and functions.

The library board is hereby declared to be an advisory board of the city of Stanwood whose duties shall be to advise and recommend to the mayor and city council in regards to the general supervision of the library facilities and programs in accordance with the contract for library service with the SnoIsle Regional Library System. (Ord. 1134 § 1, 2003; Ord. 402 § 7, 1973).

2.52.080 Use by nonresidents.

The Stanwood Community Library building was funded with liberal contributions of persons residing on Camano Island and rural northwest Snohomish County, and in grateful appreciation, the city shall never discriminate in any way against use of the
