

**RESOLUTION NO. 2021-08
CITY OF STANWOOD, WASHINGTON**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A TEMPORARY PAYMENT
PLAN FOR UTILITY CUSTOMERS ECONOMICALLY IMPACTED
DURING THE COVID-19 OUTBREAK.**

WHEREAS, businesses and individuals throughout the State of Washington have been negatively impacted by the COVID-19 outbreak, and are experiencing unprecedented economic hardship, and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to provide a form of relief to help utility customers in the City of Stanwood by granting utility payment plans for utility customers economically impacted during the COVID-19 outbreak, unless rescinded sooner or extended by the City Council,

This resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage and signatures hereto.
PASSED by the City Council at its regular meeting held on October 28, 2021.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
STANWOOD, WASHINGTON**

Section 1. The City Council authorizes the Finance Director to establish a payment plan for utility customers economically impacted during the COVID-19 outbreak, unless rescinded sooner or extended by the City Council.
