

## City of Stanwood Proclamation of Emergency

**WHEREAS**, the City of Stanwood received confirmation that the Stillaguamish River has exceeded flood stage; and

**WHEREAS**, this problem creates a threat to life and property; and

**WHEREAS**, this situation constitutes an emergency as defined by the City of Stanwood Municipal Code Chapter 2.80 Emergency Management and necessitates the utilization of emergency powers granted pursuant to City Code 2.80.010, RCW 35.33.081 and RCW 38.52.070(2);

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Leonard Kelley, the Mayor of the City of Stanwood, do hereby proclaim that an emergency exists in the City of Stanwood, therefore, city departments are authorized to do the following:

- 1) Enter into contracts and incur obligations necessary to combat such emergency situations to protect the health and safety of persons and property, and
- 2) provide appropriate emergency assistance to the victims of such disaster, and
- 3) take other emergency actions to protect life and property, as appropriate.


Each City of Stanwood department is authorized to exercise the powers vested under this proclamation in the light of the exigencies of an extreme emergency situation without regard to time consuming procedures and formalities prescribed by law (except mandatory constitutional requirements).

**This Proclamation shall be confirmed by the City Council at the earliest practicable time.**
